A. Continuation of CDCR 602, Section A only (Explain your issue): transfer. This implied Threat follows the revocation of our Scientology Volunteer Minister gate pass for both Ben Walker and Joe Riley, six months earlier (Nov-Dec 2015). Between Then and Now Chaplain Younus has implied threats of transfer on two other occasions as a means of (playful?) intimidation discouraging Appellant^(s) from continuing CDCR 22 documentation, further exacerbated by negligently leaving the Scientology locker open and material unsecured following what Younus claimed was the fault of a Security Search, or more recently the malicious destruction of Scientology CD's Chaplain Younus claims is the fault of R&R Staff. As a result of the above I've determined it prudent to resign myself from any Tuesday Chapel interaction with Chaplain Younus present and document these most recent incidents on CDCR 22 forms. I have yet to receive any reply on these frustrations are typical standard procedure by the Religious Dept. disregarding actual Policy - as was made clear in the group appeal (MCSP 15-01450) documenting efforts to co-operate from 4-30-14 to 12-4-15, as well as is substantiated by the attached DECLARATIONS of the Prisoner population, CCR 15[§] 3210 (a)(d), and DOM Article 6 indicates there is law to: "provide for the Religious and Spiritual welfare of all interested inmates", yet by the evidence of the number of CDCR 602 Appeals, and the fact MCSP has abolished the RRC right of redress, as well as by these attached DECLARATIONS^s, it is apparent that such is not the case here and now.
