I was in the process of siphoning gas, when Land came at me and grabbed me, and at that moment I caught a glimpse of his left hand being swung towards my face. I have been trained in the art of Advance Infantry Training (AIT) during the Vietnam war era. I inadvertently blocked that arm by deflecting the thrust with my right hand against his left wrist. To my surprise, the knife entered Lands body and thus caused his accidental death.
7. I was subsequently arrested and charged with the death of Michael Land.
8. I have evidence including police reports, parole documents, court transcripts, interviews and other related paperwork. To which, would prove my innocents. Lands was on parole, known by them to be an active methamphetamine user and heroin abuser, while being used by the California Department of Corrections and El Cajon Police Department as a paid informant.
9. Their motives were in retaliation against me for not being force to assist them as an informant against the *Hell's Angels*.
