Girl-Frenz (Part One): Rap Fact 1

I won \$500, first place, free recording studio time with In Da Trunk Records (Home of Coo Coo Cal's nationwide hit, 'In My Projects'), a photo shoot & biography with Hip Hop Urban Magazine, 'Ya Heard (2004 August Issue), and bragging rights for winning performance of Girl-Frenz (Part One) at Jerome Bryant's **Talent Showcase 2004** at the Milwaukee Public Library-Centennial Hall. Joe Blow came in 2^{nd place} with a song performce about aids, while Bald Head Nut came in 3rd Place performing a song about Milwaukee. We were ultimately judge by the judges on performance, clarity & messaging, mic-control, and audience participation. However, the judges only judge those who were voted by audience popularity. Each member of the audience were given a ticket and were to put only two names of their favorite acts. The more people who came to see your performance, the more chance you had at winning. Ironically, the house was full packed and the only two people whom I knew and who came to see me perform were my Mom and my older Sister. I won by a landslide, almost 95% of the votes went to me and I went up against 50 acts. It's kind of crazy because I bought tickets for everyone in the hood, my family, and friends, but no body showed up. I was kind of hurt by that but it only motivated me. I wore an all shinny-black Pascal Fit Guess Jeans & Jacket with matching plain white Guess shirt, all white Nike Air Force 1's, and an all black New Era Milwaukee Brewer's fitted baseball cap.

After winning first place at Jerome Bryant's Talent Showcase in 2004 I was also booked twice at a Milwaukee Public School by Mrs. Boone to perform Girl-Frenz and other several songs for middle & high school kids for \$800 a session.

I wrote and composed this song in 2003/2004 while incarcerated and housed in the segregation unit at Racine Correctional Facility. My Mandatory Released date was weeks away and I needed a song that could create a buzz and that could appeal to the ladies. It needed to be kind of Pop and radio friendly, so I made sure it was perfect. I produced my own music, made my own beats, wrote all of my own songs and material, and performed everything solo. I wasn't looking to get signed, I just wanted to perform my talent and entertain people. I love what I do and could care less if I got paid. However, getting paid is really nice too.
