People think what they want to think, but I know the moments I spent alone after finding the body was spent in prayer. I cried over the reality of the situation, but I wept more over this man & his family. However, torn as I was... I knew the key to survival that night.

I was pregnant with my daughter Justus at the time. I was scared. Yet, there's rules in the street that has been embedded into me that wouldn't let me turn my back on my boyz. Let alone you don't do ~~no~~ snitchin'.

Funny thing about the g-code it's broken all the time. The boyz I was helping protect... didn't protect me. Instead, they tried to put it

(the murder) off on me. But God! Though I feel the sting of their betrayal to this day, I forgive them each.

The hardest part was forgiving myself. It was not easy because I blamed myself for this man losing his life. Someone who came to the house shortly after I got in from Temple. Jose (though that's not the name he gave) gave me the vibe of a narc or snitch. I even went to my homeboy and told him I felt this way.

I can't say that this was made my boys click & do what they did. The guilt damn near consumed me and the unborn child I was carrying. The only reason I was even there that night was to tell my baby's father I was pregnant. How one decision changed the lives of so many.

I pray for Jose's family and children. I ask that they'll find within them the forgiveness of Christ to forgive me for my part in the murder of Jose. Though I didn't know what my homeboys did - I chose to help try to "fix" it afterward.

I was recently asked, "How did you feel when you found the body?" All I could answer was "the emotional pull of heart was overwhelming & felt devastation." I cried & prayed over him. Their instinct kicked in & fear took over.

I don't justify what I did, but I was not about to let what happened to him happen to me and my unborn child.

I walk in the forgiveness of a merciful God. I've repented. I've made it a vow to God to give back to others because I can't replace what my homeboys stole; but I can give my life serving God & doing His will.

If you wonder why I am posting this it's b/c I feel it's the way to tell my story, but to also, make others aware that there's freedom in admitting guilt. If we confess, we can be forgiven.

May God grant my co-defendants the same freedom I found in His forgiveness. Yet, they got to choose it for themselves.
