Why Complain? God is in Control.

In a place like this it is so easy to complain. If you don't believe me read some of the blog posts that many of the inmates write. They complain because the Department of Corrections changes this or takes that away from us. Many times they are upset because they do not understand why the powers to be make the decisions they make.

I do understand why this happens. I believe part of it is not being in control. Surrender to the authorities is one of the hardest parts of prison life. Inmates have a hard time recognizing that the guards and staff are not our peers. They all have authority over us and there is nothing we can do about it.

Now there are some who would disagree with me on this statement. These are the ones that continually write greviences or, on a greater scale, act out against the authorities thinking those actions will change be grieved action. Most of the time it does not.

What does God say about complaining? Paul tells the Philippians, "do all things without grumbling or disputing...(Phil 2:14 NASB). He tells the Thessalonians, "in everything give thanks; for this is God's will for you in Christ Jesus (I Thess. 5:18). It's not just Paul who talks about not complaining. In Psalm 34:4 David says, "I sought the Lord, and He answered me, and delivered me from all my fears." He is saying that faith and prayer exclude all complaining.

So as Christians, we are to surrender all to God and trust in him for all our needs. He is in control. Whenever you feel you have got it bad think about the following prayer. Download it and share it with others.

I PRAY FOR PEOPLE WITH EMPHYSEMA, WHOSE EYES FILL WITH TERROR AS THEY STRUGGLE FOR EVERY BREATH MERELY TO LIVE, FOR THOSE WHO ARE TORMENTED BEYOND WORDS BY IRRATIONAL FEARS, FOR THE ELDERLY WHO ARE WRACKED WITH THE PAINS OF AGING, WHOSE ONLY ESCAPE IS DEATH.

I PRAY FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE WATCHING THEIR LOVED ONES FADE BEFORE THEIR EYES THROUGH THE GRIEF OF ALZHEIMER'S DISEASE, FOR THE MANY THOUSANDS WHO ARE SUFFERING THE AGONY OF AIDS, FOR THOSE WHO ARE IN SUCH DESPAIR THAT THEY ARE CONTEMPLATING SUICIDE, FOR PEOPLE WHO ARE TORMENTED BY THE DEMONS OF ALCOHOLISM AND DRUG ADDICTION.

I PRAY FOR CHILDREN WHO HAVE BEEN ABANDONED BY THEIR PARENTS, FOR THOSE WHO ARE SEXUALLY ABUSED, FOR WIVES HELD IN QUIET DESPAIR BEATEN AND ABUSED BY CRUEL DRUNKEN HUSBANDS, FOR PEOPLE WHOSE MINDS HAVE BEEN DESTROYED BY MENTAL DISORDERS.
