The Hoax claim: Sunday Nov 8, 1998 @ 500 block State St. Madison WI 6:30 pm Mr Terry stole Steven Lewis' leather coat during a marijuana transaction. What is in dispute is Paula K's dob 3-29-81 accusation claiming that she was abducted off the 500 block of State St. Madison WI. near midnight Sunday Nov 8, 1998, for a 12 hour period, until noon Monday Nov 9, 1998 and was forced to perform an act of fellatio. alleged 5 day delayed reporting because Paula K makes police report Nov 13th. No dna samples due to no sexual assault victims kit done on Paula K. University of Wisconsin innocence project & attorney Barry Sheck will not assist pro bono because there is no dna sample which would simultaneously exclude James Terry while pointing to the real perpetrator of

of the alleged offense, which is ironic, considering Paula K's tale is a hoax.

The Concrete Alibi: Records show Sunday Nov 8, 98 7pm until Monday 7am James Terry signed into 116 W. Washington Ave. Madison WI. Drop IN Shelter, Transitional Housing INC's basement. @ 8am opens upstairs, Hospitality House, Transitional Housing INC, 116 W. Washington Ave. Madison WI. Records show "Staff BR" eyewitnesses & gives bus token to James Terry for city metro bus transportation fee for ride to employment Monday Nov 9, 98. @ 9am Monday Nov 9, 98 @ work Professional Speaking INC 1619 Monroe St. Madison WI payroll records show "Jim Terry" works 7.75 hours eyewitnessed by both Manager Shannon Linnane & Co-worker Manny Tsui until 4:45 pm.

Travesty of Justice: James' court appointed defense attorney failed to present his classic non presence alibi defense with 3 corroborating independent eyewitnesses @ bench trial. @ the same exact moment in time James Terry can't be in control & command of Paula K on East side of Madison while simultaneously eyewitnessed by 3 people with corroborating records in West Madison. James is never abducting/sexual assaulting Paula K.

Motion for withdrawal: May 29, 99 court appointed defense Attorney Edward Krueger filed his withdrawal motion as counsel for James Terry's trial. During hearing Attorney Krueger states on record "This breach in my relationship with Mr Terry, in my opinion is irreparable." Later in hearing "I cannot work with him. I do not think, in all good conscience that I could represent his interest on any level, simply because of the dynamics of his interactions with me." He has asked for a complete copy of his file and I have decline to turn that over to him." The Court decision was that Attorney Krueger would not be allowed to withdraw & trial scheduled for June 30, 1999.

@ Trial June 30 & July 1st: Attorney Krueger doesn't construe 12 hour Paula K time-line accusation. He has memorialized on a calendar an incorrect 1 hour Paula K. Sunday 11pm - midnight Nov 8, 98 chronology. So, he only erroneously has defense strategy of records & manager from 116 W. Washington Ave. Madison W.I. Drop in shelter, Transitional Housing Inc Alyssa Rader testify 7pm Sunday Nov 8 James Terry checked in with records corroborating. The Assistant District Attorney rebutted with "could Mr Terry have signed in, ate & then left?" Ms Rader answered "yes".

The Verdict Judge Patrick J. Fiedler: counts 1-6 I think
are probably a situation I would describe being
classic in criminal trials & that is who do you believe

ing allegations of this type, particularly sexual assaults
