

Gay Pride... Sticking Together! (*Dedicated to LGBTQ community)

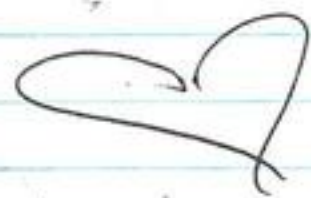
..... Hello to the World, His Precious once again!
