I know this isn't the traditional or formal way of communication, but I wanted you to experience something different, like me. So here it is, the Green Zone. It's full of information, poetry, music, lyrics, games, trivia, and the list goes on and on. It's basically everything socialable. It is what it is, so have fun and try to use your imagination, be creative, be open minded, optimistic, but overall, just be yourself. I invite you in and you are always welcome here. I hope you enjoy yourself and learn something worth learning.

Since the last time I responded, I've been through so much. I've been to see the doctor. The doctor says I have a mild case of arthritis in the left knee. I've watched several movies; Thor, Jumping the Broom, Lottery Ticket, Madea Goes to Jail, and several other new releases. I've heard a new song by my hometown (Milwaukee) local rap artist (Coo Coo Cal & Baby Drew) called "I Had A Few," and it's killing everything in the rap game right now; in my opinion. Only thing coming close to it is Lil Wayne & Drake or T.I. & Big K.R..I.T's new songs. I went to see P.R.C. (Program Review Committee) to see if I can transfer to a lower classification level prison. The Committee recommended that I be transferred to a lower classification level prison but I was denied by Madison. So, for awhile I was entertaining the thought of having more privileges and freedom, but I guess I'll have to wait until next year when I see them again. Maybe next time I'll actually get to go. I bought a brand new pair of shoes for \$59.77. They are called Adidas Floater Natural. (Visit www.wiimatepackage.com to view the shoes) I like them because they are all black with patent leather. I'm even thinking about purchasing another pair next month. (Our inmate limit is two pairs of shoes per calendar year) I also purchased some new socks, underwear, and a rug. I will also contribute about \$20 to a Memorial Scholarship Fund for charity. All this money has been earned and worked for while I've been incarcerated. I finally talked with my Mom over the phone after a few months. She sounds lovely as ever. (Hi Mom! Smile) I still haven't heard from my younger brother Marques in about 8 months, or my older sister Shenea whom promised to write me in August, or my other older sister Natasha since she got out of jail, or my other brother Keith since I've been incarcerated, or any of my nieces and nephews. That weighs heavily on my heart, mind, body and soul. Oh, I received one comment on my blog site from my guy MP. What up playa! I see you. Get at cha' boi! So shout out to him for leaving that comment. And shout out to BTB (Between the Bars) for commenting on my site with all the new information and updates.

I'll try to come up with a logo design soon even if it's after the deadline. Drawing and creating is a passion of mine and I have a lot of ideas and concepts for you. So be on a look out for that. As for any one out there who may be interested with leaving a comment or anyone who wants to write to me personally, this is what I have to say to you, "Don't be scared, just be yourself. That's the main key. I'm presenting myself to you as myself. So it's only natural for you to do the same. Don't be a stranger. Either we'll accept each other or we won't but we'll never know unless we put in the effort. I'm doing my part, now it's time for you to do yours if you are interested. Until then, I'll cut this short but never the love.
