1. FLOUR TORTILLAS- Brought in three samples for the MAC committee to try and decide which brand would work best.
2. SHREDDED BEEF- Should arrive any day.
3. TREND LAUNDRY DETERGENT- MAC has decide on Trend with Bleach Alternative to replace Sun laundry detergent. The price will be \$2.10 per box.
4. HANDBALLS-Handballs cannot be sold in the canteens per DOM.
5. C-YARD QUARTERLY CHOICE- C yard would like to replace hair picks for loofahs.
6. BASEBALL CAPS- We are looking into getting Proflex caps with the band all the way around instead of plastic or Velcro.
7. HOLIDAY COOKIES- Winter mint cookies will be ordered for an additional holiday item. The cookies are chocolate covered with mint inside for \$2.35, will be available for a limited time.

Subject: Visiting Meeting Overview

On 11.7.2011 the M.A.C. Unitary Body & Subcommittee Chairmen met with Lt. ~~Wenderson~~ to discuss and/or resolve various issues placed on the monthly agenda.

The issues are as follows:

1. 115s for Drugs & Paraphenalia: Inmates who receive 115s for either drugs or drug paraphenalia will lose contact visits pending the outcome of the write-up. Rather than being able to have contact visits, these inmates will only be allowed to visit their people behind glass.
2. Visiting Bathrooms: Lt. ~~Wenderson~~ is looking into whether or not visitor bathrooms will be kept open until visits close.
3. Ceiling Tiles: Lt. ~~Wenderson~~ is checking on the possibility of replacing damaged, miscolored ceiling tiles in the visiting room.
4. Vendors: In order to give inmates and their visitors better access to food/beverages during visiting hours, the M.A.C. asked if the vendors could come in the middle of the day instead of the end of the day. Lt. ~~Wenderson~~ is following up on this request.
5. Required Information on Visiting Forms: Visitors are required to disclose all information related to juvenile records (even if they've been expunged).
