Subject : Food Service Meeting Overview

On 11.16.2011 the M.A.C. met with Food Service staff to discuss and/or resolve various issues placed on the quarterly agenda.

The issues are as follows:

1. **B Side Coffee:** Coffee tempature will be adjusted as requested.
2. **Jelly:** Complaints about the poor quality of jelly passed out with lunches has become a statewide issue. As a result, PIA is working to improve it.
3. **Biscuits:** Cooks will be asked to prepare morning biscuits so they are not so hard.
4. **Coffee Cake:** To ensure better portioning of morning coffee cake, food service will speak to the baker and ask that it is cut in a way that will provide nicer pieces for the population.
5. **Dirty Trays:** Food service will check the tempature of the water in the tray washer to see if low water temps are contributing to issues with dirty trays. If the water temp is too low, a work order will be submitted to Plant Ops to fix the problem.
6. **Corn Tortillas:** Corn tortillas will no longer be served with meals. *Flour Only*
7. **Missing Fruit:** Food service will instruct dining staff to have fresh fruit ready to hand out.
8. **Canned Fruit:** Specific types of canned fruit are not pulled from warehouse shelves. Fruit is passed out according to what is readily in position to be pulled from the warehouse.

Changes: The following changes are expected to happen December 6th, 2011.

* Insulin Users: Fruit & crackers will be served in the chow hall, must provide a chrono.

* Liquid Nutrition: Carnation drinks will be delivered with CTQ cards. Each delivery will provide a week's supply of carnation drinks.
