Who Is Funding Gov. Scott Walker?

Gov. Walker likes to allege that he is the victim of outof-state agitators who are interfering in Wisconsin politics. He has provided no evidence to support this allegation. However, there is ample evidence that the majority of Gov. Walker's monetary support is coming from wealthy out-of-state supporters.

The news media has reported that in the last 5 weeks Gov. Walker has received \$4.5 million, \$2.5 million of which came from out-of-state donors. Three Missouri donors each contributed \$250,000 and one Texas billionaire, Bob Perry, donated \$250,000 twice. Kerry wrongly believed that the American public knew better than to believe the lies told about him. In reality, Kerry was a true war hero. Sadly, he misjudged the public's gullibility and his failure to respond to the ads cost him the election. He was the first to be "Swift-Boated". Now, the man behind the Swift-Boat ads has given Gov.
