Dear population member,


On behalf of the Men's Advisory Council, Vice-Chairman Menendez and I want to address a few topics with you directly. First some rumor control. There are no plans in place to reduce the building population. The Warden will need to make significant program cuts late summer or fall, due to reductions in staff. The possibility of eliminating third watch program is seriously being considered. However, we plan to offer alternative solutions that make more sense for Facility "A". We have programmed successfully on this yard for a long time and the population deserves a third watch program. Currently we are seeing controlled feeding in the evening. That will continue because we have lost a third watch yard staff position.

Now we are pleased to discuss some good news. The M.A.C. has won approval to re-open the lunchtime yard for A1A inmates. We have been working for this result a long time. Close-A custody inmates and A2B status inmates must still go in at 11:45 during the week. Instead of yard recall, an announcement will be made for all A2B and all Close-A custody inmates to report back to their units. Failure to do so will result in a yard recall to locate missing inmates. Continual problems in reporting on time could result in the cancellation of lunchtime yard. The new yard program will begin soon. We have done the job to get this new privilege for the population, now its up to you to keep it! We continue to fight for an expansion of the A2B yard program.

A few other matters. There is no more third watch R&R package program. We are exploring approval for PIA to get a priority ducat for packages. In the meantime R&R will try to get these packages out before 2:45 pm and on Saturdays. The rise in canteen prices is completely controlled by Headquarters. The Visiting chair issue has been resolved in our favor, the chairs along the wall will remain.

Thank you for your support. We will keep you updated on any program changes.
