Dear Mr. Perez:

As you know, on **November 18, 2011**, the Advisory Board of Pardons recommended to Governor Deval Patrick that he deny your request for executive clemency. Pursuant to Section IV(2) of the Governor's Executive Clemency Guidelines, since the Governor has neither disapproved of nor taken any other action on that recommendation within 90 days, it is presumed that the Governor concurs in that adverse recommendation. Accordingly, your petition has been denied without prejudice.

Please be advised that you may not submit an application for a pardon until **February 18, 2013**, one year from the date the petition was denied.

A copy of this letter has been forwarded to the Office of the Governor's Chief Legal Counsel.
