Re: STAFF MISCONDUCT COMPLAINT / REQUEST FOR INVESTIGATION

Dear Commissioner Spencer:

On Thursday, April 12, 2012, at approximately 6:05 PM, I was instructed by MCI Shirley, Unit E-2, C.O. Archibald, to report to see Lt. Mahjahoski (I am unsure of the spelling of his name) the HSU 3-11 Shift Supervising Lieutenant at the HSU. When I arrived at the HSU I was met by the Lieutenant who asked me to take a seat in the holding cell. In a matter of seconds a woman appeared and said, "I am Dr. Walker and I wanted to ask you about a letter you wrote to the Boston Globe which had my name in it." I responded to her, "I will not be providing you with any answers." She stated, "Well I have never met you before and I wanted to ask you why you sent the letter to the Globe and who gave you your information." I responded, "Again, I am not going to be providing you with any answers to your questions." I then said to the Lieutenant, who was present during the entire interaction, "I do not want to be called up here unless it is for medical or official DOC reasons." The Lieutenant struggled for words, but then said, "This is a DOC reason." I responded, "I will handle that my own way." I then left the HSU and returned to my housing unit where I called my sister and asked her to contact my lawyers.

Please consider this my **FORMAL REQUEST** for an **INVESTIGATION** into this blatant staff misconduct. Psychiatrist Jerri Walker abused her position as a contractual care provider to summons me to the HSU to ask me personal questions. She used security staff as an accomplice in this matter, and the supervising Lieutenant improperly characterized this as a "DOC" matter. Dr. Walker and Lieutenant Mahjahowksi (phonetic) abused their positions to interrogate me on a personal matter of free speech. I ask that they be disciplined to the full extent of your power for these actions.


