Killgore can be seen on video P Dorm 2 Floor 2 wing Left side standing over me here at my cell Front P-2204 and was trying to antagonize me. When he couldn't get me to respond he stated "you don't need to say anything, I can say you said anything that I want you to say." When they placed me back in my cell, he Lt. Killgore can be seen standing in front of my cell still trying to get me to say something. He was telling the Officer's as they walked by my cell, you heard what he called you?!" "you heard what he just said?!" Lt. Killgore stated I was a racist among other derogatory comments. I'm calling for a Full Inspector General investigation I'm calling for all the inmates that were back here to be interviewed. I'm calling for the video to be screened and preserved as evidence of further acts of Reprisal. This I.G. investigation is a must. Thank you for your time and hopefully your help the video will show Sgt. Swain having to place the lock back on my door at 10:33am. They were so busy messing with me they over looked a security matter of placing the lock back on
