I pray that this note finds you in the best of spirits, enjoying a good day. In a previous post I shared about being forgiven for all the wrong we have ever done. I want to expound on that a bit now. Some may feel as though they are not the responsible one in any wrong doing. We are always responsible for our wrong doing before God as well as man. Lets get real and check this out.

Have you ever told a lie? Have you ever stolen any little thing? How about lusted after another person? A truthful answer to these questions has to be Yes! We are all guilty of these things. So from a Holy Gods perspective we are all lying, adulterous thieves. That is just the way it is. You cannot expect to get to heaven if your good deeds out weigh the bad, they won't. We all need forgiveness, from God and from eachother.

God sent His son, the man Jesus Christ to pay the penalty for the sins of the world. You don't need to "get religion". You only have to go to God and admit that you need forgiveness, that you are wiling to accept on faith that Christ died for your sins and mine.
