8:01 am Got my cell all cleaned up. waiting on legal mail. I just gave the officer my black pen for his blue pen, because their not allowed to do paper work with a blue pen. I try to get along with all the staff. and if I can do something like that for them, I don't mind at all. we heard officer Dobbs whose also the mayor of Union County is suppose to start working over here today, but I didn't see him come by. I'm going to walk for a while. and then finish this greeting card that I'm working on.

8:28 am I gave that blue pen back to the officer. I got to looking at it, it has a spring inside the pen, and I don't want anything in here that they can write me a D.R. for saying its escape material. I had an extra black pen so I just let the officer keep the other one. It doesn't really matter, if they want to write me a D.R. they will just have an officer plant something the way Sgt. they did on Sept 1, 2011 when he said he found 3 razor blades in the cell. But I'm not going to make it easy for them and have something in here that's not suppose to be here. If they want me they got to break



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their rules and set me up.

8:46am Co. sexton just picked up legal mail and my letter going to the Jacksonville Lawyer Referral Center. I hope something good comes out of that.

9:14am Mayor Dabbs is in the control room. We have restricted movement because of the fog outside. So the law library and everything is going to be running behind.

12:02PM I wrote a letter and worked on a card.

Made me two burritos for lunch, still waiting on the law library. I'll go down there about 1, 1:30PM. Right now I'm watching the news.

6:11PM I got back from the law library and did some legal work, then got into some art work. Then Iron Man II came on so I stopped to watch that. Then I went back to this card got that finished. Now I'm fixing to wash my cloths and watch the news and call it a day.

I'd love to be out on the beach. Hell I'd rather be any where but here. Drop me off in the middle of the ocean, at least I'd find hope there and the will to survive. This damn cell just deflates the hope out of you. Well at least the Governor didn't sign a warrant this week. That's the one good thing that come out of this week. I got the grievance back on Lt. Milgore stating it would be turned over to the I.G. I'll be placing that up on the blog. As well as a couple of other documents that I want to share. I need to do some art work, and write, workout and get back to work on this formal complaint.



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I need to get going right now.

12:49 PM I've been working on this Formal Complaint all morning. I stopped and made a Fish stew for lunch. I'm fixing to watch Track and Field then the Heat play the Knicks and then the auto race. so I'm not going to get alot done today.

5:04 PM just finished eating. I've been watching the basket ball game and was working on this Formal Complaint. I'm finished with it. It's 7 pages. I've got to go over some things darkening it in. Right now I'm waiting on the shower.

✿ SUNDAY APRIL 29, 2012 7:36 am our power just went OFF about ten minutes ago. I think the person in the Controll room is playing games. That happens from time to time. Today is Dina's birthday. she's probably still asleep. Last night I did some more work on darkening in this Formal Complaint. I've still got some more work to do on it. probably won't finish it for a couple of days. I'm going to work on it some more here in a few minutes. Then do some art. I need to finish this letter to my mom and send a card out. I need to get to this.

8:03 am They just cut the power back on. I'm working on this Formal Complaint.

3:06 PM I've been working all day long, doing art, Hooking up some stationary putting my logo on the back of my cards. I'm fixing to watch a basket ball game.

6:08 PM just finished washing clothes and bathing. I'm watching the abc world news and a Family of seven was killed at the Bronx zoo when the van went over an over pass.



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so sad. I'm going to call it a day finish  
watching the news then 60 minutes the  
Amazing Race go to sleep and start this  
sh\*\* all over again tomorrow.

Re: Letter of Complaint

Inmate Clark:

Your letter of complaint has been received and reviewed.

With regard to your complaint concerning the P Dorm longevity moves, Warden Barry Reddish advises that the decision to conduct these moves was made by the administration in keeping with the Security and Good Daily Order of the institution. Contrary to your statements, we have observed no increase in fights, assaults, or other violent activities as a result of the moves. The administration is not intentionally trying to cause friction as you allege and there have been no documented cases of anyone contacting bio-hazards as a result of the longevity movement.

Security pens are necessary in Death Row as a staff and inmate safety precaution. Also, the decision to limit special housing units (including Death Row) to boneless chicken was made by a former administration at the institution and the current administration agrees with the security precaution of restricting potentially dangerous chicken bones from these units.

Warden Reddish advises that there is no merit to your allegation that he does not like death row inmates. He indicates that he has spoken to numerous death row inmates about their televisions and reception and that he has personally viewed numerous channels at cell front to ensure that the number of channels being received is a reasonable amount.

Chapter 33-601.830 mandates that death row inmates are to be provided 6 hours of out of cell activities during each week; however, it does not specify how such hours are to be conducted. It has been considered prudent and security wise to give these 6 hours in 2 three-hour increments. This is far better for death row inmates than the 4 hours of minimum exercise that were afforded in years past. With regard to letting inmates out of their cells to roam around in the hallways, this type of activity would be dangerous and a threat to institutional security. Therefore, your request is denied. Death Row inmates receive the use of telephone privileges by request for emergency purposes only; however, legal phone calls are routinely granted and conducted.

The guidelines for Keefe canteen pricing and the operations of the canteen review committee are overseen by Central Office. Death Row inmates are not allowed to possess MP3 Players or CD Disks, nor can they receive such items through a package permit program. There is no current consideration being given toward allowing death row inmates to possess hot pots and typewriters.

In regard to your request to consider changing rules to allow death row inmates to place ads for pen pals, the very reason that this is not allowed is precisely because inmates have traditionally used this avenue to solicit funds from citizens. Such solicitation is forbidden and will not be allowed.

I hope this response is informative and that it addresses your concerns sufficiently.
