And He shall provide all your needs...

In the Bible, the second book to the Corinthians, Chapter 5, verse 17, we are told that if anyone be "in Christ" he is a new creation. Yesterday, after watching Charles Stanley, my favorite preacher, I felt the Lord sitting me down. Stanley's message was on Anger, a topic that I will save for another time, as it is a long one with me, but one that has passed away. For the millionth time old sins I have committed began to replay in my mind, and that old soul kiling shame grew strong. But the God very simply said enough. It is finished. I do not understand just what happened yesterday. I do not know why it took me twenty years to be able to say the old things are passed away. It is just the way it is. I have great sorrow over my past actions to be sure. But I am no longer sitting in the filth of my past, this to is my experience. It is amazing.

That verse ends with "behold the new has come." I am excited to see how that plays out in my experience. :)
