Guards By Me on Alpha Unit

- In cell 204 is an old-school convict, Sean Riker, accused by his wife (falsely, from what I've seen) of numerous acts of physical, sexual, & mental abuse of his step-daughters, and making her rob ATMs with him, which has wrecked his sanity.

You tell me who seems more... curious, where the story lies? Right now, it's with my fellow captives. I can't help but wonder how we/they got that way.

Now, on Echo unit the staff are much more aggressive, manipulative, dirty & deranged. I'll be back there in about September, when I'm put back on Admin. Conf. & will devote some posts to revealing how they tick.
