Dear Mr. Muise:

I am in receipt of your letter dated February 16, 2012 and your letter to Acting Chief of Investigation dated February 23, 2012, alleging retaliation by the Assignment Officer.


I have reviewed your allegations and offer you the following. You have not been cleared for a library position due to your prior disciplinary history, which includes initiating a group demonstration, circumventing mail system, ordering magazine subscriptions for other inmates, as well as other serious infractions. This type of adjustment deems you unsuitable for clearance as a library worker.

I have been advised by that he did indeed erroneously place a cellmate with you on February 16, 2012 which was an inappropriate match. This error was corrected within a twenty-minute period and was not found to be malicious on the part of the Assignment Officer, rather, human error resulting from the multiple room changes conducted on a daily basis coupled with multiple tasks assigned. HE DID IT AGAIN FOUR DAYS LATER!

Your claims of retaliation are not substantiated. I would encourage you to apply for a unit runner work assignment, as this seems to be the most appropriate position for you to begin to establish a positive work record.
