Upon arrival I was directed by the station deputy to the detectives' office whereupon I was greeted, instead, by three Los Angeles City Police detectives who advised me that they were there to affect an arrest warrant, made on the sworn affirmation of prosecutor, Harvey Giss! the prosecutor whose plea offer I had rejected in the then pending self-defense; alleging, falsely, that I and a Marshal L. Bridges (aka. Khumasi L. Bridges; aka Khumasi L. Pruett) were responsible for the 18th June 1984 murders of my friend Larry Turner; and an acquaintance, Roger Grant whom Larry had recently introduced as a person having helpful information about Mr. Edward Lewis' and his paid false testimony.

Larry Turner and Roger Grant was not of a membership of any of the several disruptive street and/or prison gangs.

Consequently this false double murder complaint with special (capital) circumstances was filed causing the revocation of my (\$50,000.-) bail bond in the pending self-defense and extreme prejudice to handicap my defense and a fair trial in the previously filed and pending self-defense - murder complaint.

The self-defense pretrial and trial was conducted in the courtroom of Judge Ronald S.W. Lew. Judge Lew ruled during pretrial of the proceedings and during the course of the (so-called) trial that my lawyers, Stephen Schwartz and Janis A. Rader, could not present "Proximate Cause" of death expert medical evidence contrary to that misrepresented by the prosecuting attorney!
