XZ with our growing custom here, let me say what an honor it is to vize with you right now, New Generation Living.

IM I'm a pretty strange bird, I hope you feel the same after this.

XZ So where did you live before you got arrested to come to death row?

IM I was living in the Bay Area before my arrest.

XZ It's also well known that you have a mother here on the Row, so who's the oldest?

IM I am the oldest by a year 1/2.

XZ So how have you been holding up for yourself and your lil' bro?

IM I'm in my own internal personal heaven because I am the author of my own energies, my emotions do not depend on any external circumstances, I see myself as the creator of all of my results and therefore am able to take responsibility for what I create and because of this I am at peace with what is.

X7 What was the energy of the youth in your community before you got to deathrow?

EM I never paid much attention to the community outside of my circle of friends, the energy of humanity in general seemed to me to be more self involved than I remember when I was a youth (and more materialistic).

XZ Is deathrow anything near the way you thought it was before you touched down up here?

EM No, not at all, my only prison experience prior to being arrested was Hollywood which portrayed prisoners as evil and people in uniform as good. It's truth is nowhere near as simple as that. There are so many good people incarcerated and so many people in uniform who's authority has begun to corrupt them to a point where they lower their standards and ethics to a level where they can feel they're a little bit better than the people they are guarding. When the standard of conduct is to be a little bit better than those whom society has condemned to death, that conduct can become petty and vindictive very quickly. Then when they see a measure of goodness within a

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prisoner that exceeds their own, their shame creates a resentment and lashing out against that prisoner and others that conduct themselves with more integrity than they do. Never the less, for the most part I feel that San Quentin is significantly more humane than I expected and I'm grateful that I wasn't incarcerated even 30 years ago, the struggles of the inmates before me are serving me well today.

XZ That's just one of the reasons why our new generation observe Black August, which is a great segue into the ultimate Black August question, Did you get a fair trial?

Im Define Fair, did they obey all of the rules that they themselves put in place? No, not at all. Under threat of death was one of our co-defendants that offered an incentive for them to lie and tell a story that fit the prosecutors theories and version of events, absolutely not fair.

XZ That part of the Hollywood story is true, continue your thought because although people will say it may be cliché, the overwhelming accounts of crime reporters snitching on their homeboys now satisfies true justice speak on that.

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EM Any measure of true healing within them, man, how can they feel that Justice has been served if they are waiting 20 years or more for my death. Every breath they take is a breath I share with them until California kills me so that they can feel peace in the heart once again. How can this crazy Justice System set up the families of the victims in such a cold way that their peace depends on anything to do with me. If I had been sentenced to life without, they could get a measure of peace from the sense that Justice had been served. It's sick, it's totally twisted and the irony is I'm not worried about getting life without in the next election, it's gonna happen eventually. On a personal level I'd rather wait another 15 years because the appeals process will be already rolling, but philosophically speaking, for the benefit of humanity, this bullshit should be stopped tomorrow.

NZ OMG, My lil essay potna Bandito just described this shit as Sick and Twisted, and now here you are saying the same exact words. I'm serious, and in that order Sick first and then Twisted.

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FN When you say essay you do mean Mexican right?
I don't know him, but whoever he is his
choice of words hit the nail on the head
at whatever capacity on this issue.

XZ Borchio is one of those youngsters around here
that is not a slave, so he is free to say
whatever he wants to and when he said sick
and twisted he was also drawing energy from
a piece of artwork he had just completed
when we chopped it up about the death penalty,
you might be on to something, and you
should take pride in your naivete as to
what an essay is, it's an honest display of
you not wasting 80 years in prison, a feat
that so many idiots take pride in, as if
any amount of honor should be applied to
this shit, hell man, I get embarrassed everytime
I tell kids I was in the Youth Authority, so
sick and twisted also applies to the psychological
effects of all captives because it's equally sick
and twisted everytime I hear someone
explain with an eerie pride that they
have done extensive prison time in several
institutions as some kind of badge of honor worthy of
the new generation's respect, adoration and
loyalty. Don't nobody care how long people been in prison
it's your current value status as a human that is most important.

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So now, I ask you, with your white, naive, aint never been nowhere, young ass, what advice could you give any parent faced with learning that their own 16 year old daughter has just been arrested and placed in the very same Juvenile Detention Facilities that the parent was in as a youth?

IM Love Her, Love Her, Love Her and most importantly, make sure she clearly sees that you are on her side, an ally that she can come to with anything and about anything. "Inner Criticism and resistance to what is" are almost every Teenager's worst enemies... so if you can inspire her to love herself no matter what and embrace "what is" I believe her life will head in a better direction. Being hyper-critical of ones self is so major for our youth today. Also encourage her to know and understand that everything she does creates a result so when she doesn't like what she has created with her actions and responses to the issues of life, she will be able to begin to foresee her results before she does anything, one in which she is not the victim ~~to~~ circumstances, but rather a powerful creator. She's not stupid, she is a leader that needs a Father, You!

The divide and conquer primitive tactics used for years do not work against The New Generation, The Era of the Snitch Kite, manufactured paperwork, and corrupt cop set up sick and twisted conduct will not achieve the level of success it had against the many generations of captives that have both been misled and or participated in some capacity to cause division between men and women throughout prison history.
