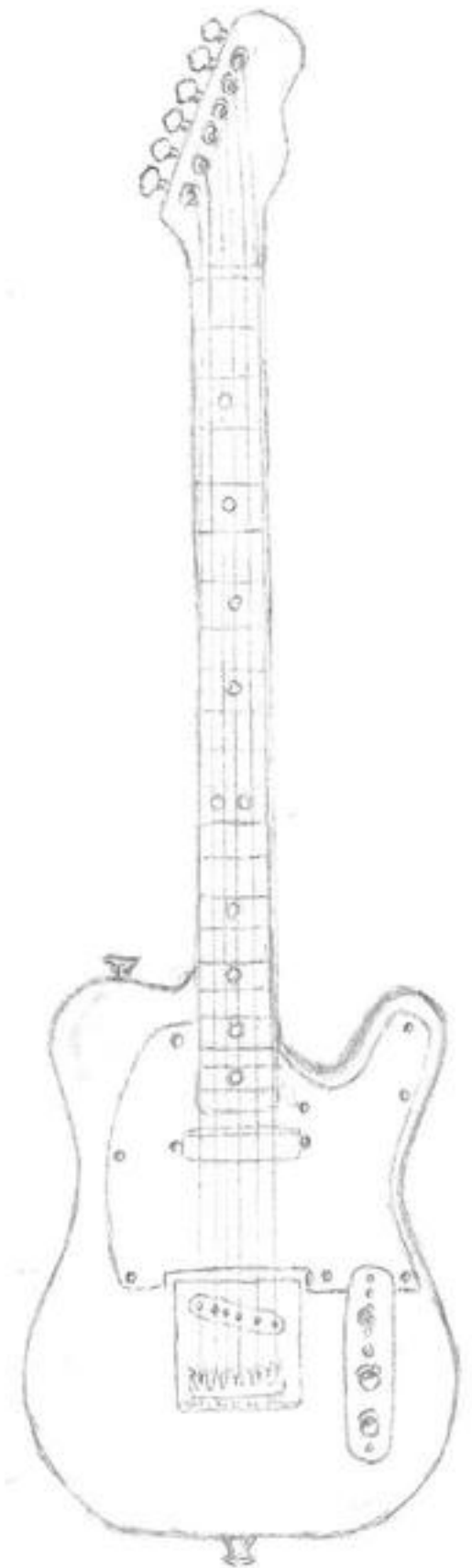
Friends and Family,
