WRITE OR DIE (Issue 2)

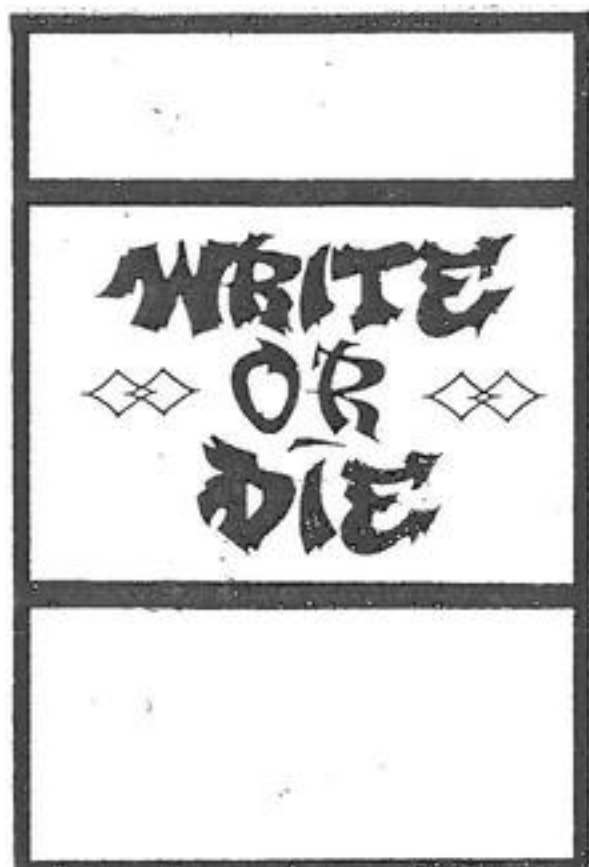

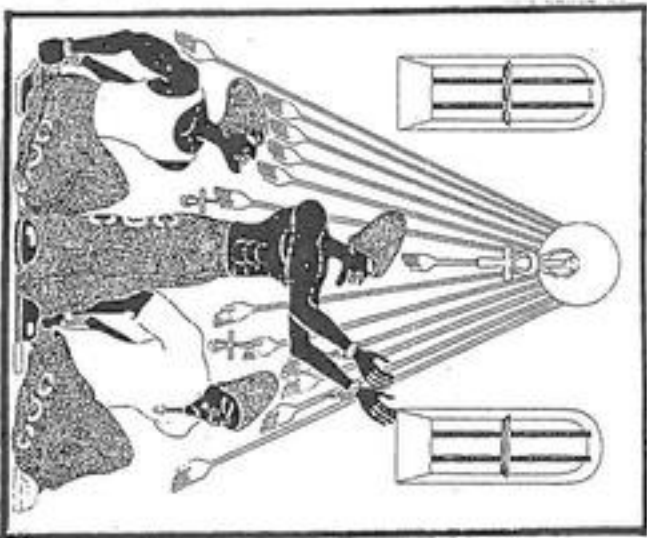

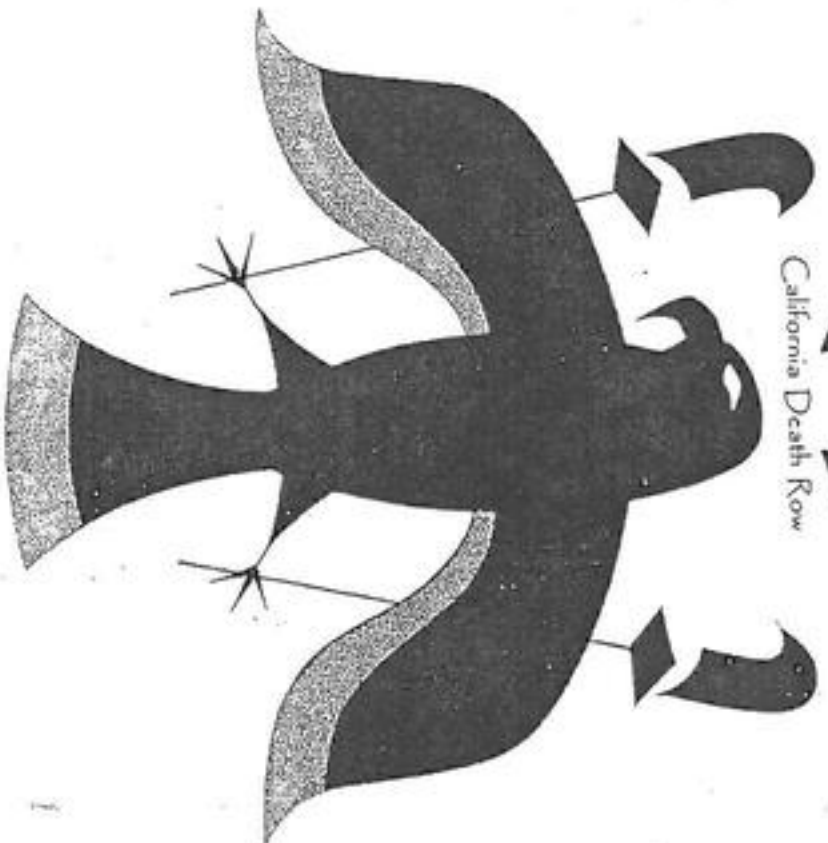
