I gave away all my peanut butter and jelly, anyway. I have a very strong dislike for both(long story), so trying to eat peanut butter and jelly was extremely hard.

Things are getting back to normal slowly, not that normal is good here, but it is what it is, and I made my bed so I must lie in it. I hope that you will read my next blog, which I will post mid May, on Malcolm X. Any advice? I hope that you will at least let me know what you think about it. I know that Malcolm X was a polarizing figure in the American movement for human rights, but for me I see pass all the negative propaganda. So mid May, hopefully.
