The truth is I am no longer the person Daniel knew in Germany but I am also no longer the person who committed murder. People can choose to continue to hate me for the person I was 30 years ago but that person is already dead!

Unfortunately I can not undo the past and all the pain I caused. But I can honor God and life by giving Him my adoration daily and never doing anything I know is wrong. And through an intimate relationship with my Lord and Savior I will continue to live a victorious life no matter where I live it!
