difficult approach to defend against, this is for the sector of the working^{class} who support radical workers rights struggle, & who believe that the working class must be organize along radical lines, or there will not be a working class, that there will only be the rich getting richer & the poor getting poorer, the geo political implications of a general strike, is that international crisis will be amplified, there is a domestic national front of this struggle, with the popularizing the general strike in the domestic prisoner population, & this my blog is a official site of this national front,
