I am writing to inform you that my District Office has received your correspondence concerning mental health treatment. After reviewing your materials, my staff is contacting the United States Bureau of Prisons to request an investigation of this matter and provide my office with a written response detailing their findings.

After initial agency contact, my office must allow the United States Bureau of Prisons a minimum of one month to reply to our inquiry. Thereafter, a follow-up letter is submitted on your behalf. I share your desire to resolve this matter in a timely fashion. Please understand that the United States Bureau of Prisons deals with a relatively high volume of inquiries and, as such, I would ask for your patience throughout this process.
