Well in the last chapter I told you about how on July 4 CO Swinehount had told me that the shift commander, Capt. Can't-NoWay, had told him that he was to open "only" the law library and to keep the general library closed. not only did I blog about the lazy ass tomfoolery, but I also wrote a formal complaint letter to Deputy Denied-Oh. She responded this week with her usual propaganda buzz-words like "unable to predict emergencies" (which means cops call in sick), "the captain was not aware" (which means CO Swinehount was lying), "your observation" (she tries to call me a liar), etc., but the bottom line is that the complaint to Deputy Denied-Oh ferreted out the fact that it was CO Swinehount who was lying and now that she has spoken to Capt. Can't-NoWay he will chew out Swinehount for tossing his names into the mix. I love the fact that we can pull their covers when they just plain refuse to do there job. It was not enough that CO Swinehount was getting about \$50.00 per hour for "Holiday Pay" he still had to try to take his required "nap" during the shift.

They have another audit coming up here at the prison and they have already started dumping your taxpayer dollars down the drain. They painted some still "wet" showers (like they do for every audit) and the paint is already peeling off. They have had the walks and grounds crew out cutting grass and fixing plants like that will help the failures here. They strip the floors and throw wax on them but ignore the black mold in the showers or on the walls. They wash ralings while leaving open fiber-glass insulation hanging from the gym ceiling. The did not pass out our one hotel size bar of soap this week and gave no extra toilet paper to the blocks (as they always do). I would like to know the exact date when the prison administration and hatefull guards like Lt. Whirlwind decided that we did not even deserve toilet paper and soap anymore? They have dehumanized the prisoner to such a state where the next step will be guards murdering prisoners here and calling them suicides. It is not too far off. How is an indigent man supposed to wash his hands without soap? You have 80+ year old men, with decades straight in prison, who have no family of friends left (they have died off after 40 years) and need that soap and toliet paper. Lt. Whirlwind says "F Them", literally, and I heard her myself call one of these old men the foulest of female body part curses when he walked off. This degenerate called this man a C. We all know who the "C" is. (And she called him this to Deputy Denied-Oh right on the walkway!)

The is a very sick, one legged, old man up in the HSU who is fighting for better living conditions. He was filed a federal lawsuit against The Boot, Denied-Oh and some of the other malfeasants here. He just had a hearing where a false affidavit was submitted by Deputy Denied-Oh where she makes clearly false representations about the make up of this man's cell in the HSU. He is working hard to get the court to see her blatant lies: and we all hope he succeeds. I gave him the name of a lawyer who may be able to help. He really needs to expose this consumate liar. Imagine living in a prison hospital, elderly, with only one leg, and being denied the most basic humane housing requirements? God bless this guy for fighting the power!

I went out to the oxymoronic "Happy Hour" (not voluntarily) to see Lt. Burry-Anus who is the grievance officer. You see I filed two grievance about two weeks ago and due to his "heavy work load" Lt. Burry-Anus is just getting around to my complaints. I am challenging The Boot and Denied-Oh's contention that I "do not have the authority to invite people into the prison". Oh are they wrong. I have the constitutional right to complain about conditions of confinement through the use of the mail and one aspect of those complaints is to ask government officials to come in to the prison and view the adverse confinement conditions themselves. I have to file such a grievance so I can get these bastards to put their position in writing as I plan on litigating the issue. Lt. Burry-Anus played eaf and dumb, as is his job, and looked like he was missing his girlfriend who got suspended from working here last year for fighting with another feamble guard. He did not have too much to say when I broke it all down for him, but did respond by sending me a notice that he needed 10 more days to "investigate" my claims The second grievance was about them cutting my pay by .50¢ a day (he also needed 10 more days to investigate that!). He can make \$85,000.00 + a year but they don't want me to get \$2.00 per day. It sure ain't my pay which adds up the \$362,000,000.00 in yeraly salaries.

The heat wave has been unbearable in here. They call a couple hundred guys to the oven of a chow hall here and then the guards turn the fans to point at one or two of them instead of at the 200 prisoners who have to sit over hot trays. A few cons have stood up, turned the fans themselves, and got into jawing matches with dirtbags like Sgt. Mac-Hardly (who only fights after the prisoner in handcuffed) and CO Little-Chicken as he is still angry about not making the height requirement at Disney Land (even as an adult). They deliver ice cold water to these dirtballs but we can't even get soap. The chowhall is like an oven and they even want to take our fans. One of these days it is all going to explode. I hope I am in my cell typing a "Brief History...." (-;

A lot of guys who were at our meeting with State Representative Benjamin Swan are experiencing trouble with their mail. That is not a coincidence. They open our incoming mail: if they don't want us to see it they toss it. They open and copy our outgoing mail: if they don't like the message they toss it. The mailroom guard is a former IP (elite shitbag force) who got tossed off the IPS as he patted down a female guard (a guard who was targeted as she had given a photo of herself in a bikini to a prisoner and the guards found it) and she filed a harassment claim. he is on super-anger level and is charged with handling our mail: it is all by design. We are in contact with local and federal mail authorities and are going to do our best to hold someone accountable. I hope it is CO Shitty in the mailroom.

Complaint Superintendent Ryan, in writing, and Deputy [REDACTED] verbally (at my June 24, 2013, forced meeting with her and Deputy notice) have informed me that it is their opinion that I do not have the right to ask government officials to come here to the prison to view/hear about negative confinement conditions. I must offer that this is in violation of my constitutional rights as protected by the United States Constitution. I may complain to government officials through the use of outgoing U.S. mail about negative confinement conditions, and my free speech rights under the U.S. constitution allow part of those complaints to be a request for government officials to come to the prison and view/hear about those negative conditions first hand. This would also apply to an invitation to any other civilian who also has a First Amendment right to receive such information, just as I have that First Amendment right under Procunier v. Martinez, 416 U.S. 396.

Remedy Requested Be provided a written statement that my First Amendment to the U.S. Constitution right to complain about conditions of confinement through the use of the outgoing mail will not be restricted in any way.

Complaint My institutional pay was recently cut from \$2.00 per day to \$1.50 per day for no apparent reason. The pay scales, under G.L. c. 124, ss1. referring you to G.L. c. 127, ss 48A, are under the control of the commissioner of correction. To reduce my pay usurps the authority of those powers. Further, Deputy [REDACTED] has increased the pay of prisoners housed in the Lifer's Unit D-1. Prisoners there had their pay increased from \$1.00 & \$1.50 per day to \$2.00 per day. Under the equal protection clause of the United States Constitution, as well as the Massachusetts Constitution and Declaration of Rights, I must be afforded equal treatment as other prisoners similarly situated. For the Deputy to decrease my pay (pay mandated to have 50% saved for reentry purposes) so she can increase other prisoner pay and/or expand jobs, violates my equal protection rights. Additionally, my pay cut may be retaliation for confinement complaints made under my First Amendment rights, thus cruel and unusual.

Remedy Requested Return me to my previous pay rate of \$2.00 per day.
