I WANT TO GRIEVE: WSP IMU-S property C/O [REDACTED] is refusing to let me go through my property to search for my legal work and to pack my property and label it. All my property at WSP are items such as hygiene items already authorized in IMU and papers. There's no electronics, no art supplies, no razors, there's no security risk. MCC, WCC, CBCC, and SCCC all allow IMU inmates to search for legal work and pack up their property. Grievance #12515578 blamed me for not packing my own property. The problem is at WSP the IMU property C/O refuses to let me pack my property. In my cell at SCCC IMU I had 1 full box of legal work, so far C/O [REDACTED] has only given me half a box. **I WANT TO MAKE THIS PERFECTLY CLEAR. I HAVE 3 ACTIVE COURT CASES. C/O [REDACTED] IS REFUSING TO LET ME SEARCH FOR MY LEGAL WORK AND HIS METHOD OF SEARCHING ISN'T WORKING.** It took 3 weeks just to get half a box doing things his way!

SUGGESTED REMEDY: Allow me to go to a secure holding cell with all my property to search for legal work and to pack and label my property. [3/7/13]

<p>I WANT TO GRIEVE: appeal to Level II. On 3/21/13 C/O [REDACTED] and I went through 1 box of my legal work. At the end of this there was very few items left in the box so I asked him to put the property in with the IMU S storage property box which is almost empty to. He said no, that it's going to storage. This means my property is getting stretched out. I've asked to go through all my legal boxes to get my legal work, then pack and label my own boxes, instead C/O [REDACTED] is going through my boxes looking for legal work that he has never seen before, thus he's just guessing. This method is taking a long time, its been over 2 months and I still don't have all my legal work. Having access to paperwork in a camera cell is not a security issue, its done in IMU N as well as all other IMU's statewide. I'm suppose to be given reasonable access to my legal work, having C/O [REDACTED] blunder through my boxes is not reasonable nor is it working. In grievance #12515578 I was grieving WSP charging me for my legal boxes to transfer, I was told its my fault for not packing and labeling my boxes. Yet WSP won't let me. That C/O [REDACTED] put an almost empty box in storage shows he's creating extra boxes I'll have to pay for like he did last time. I paid \$40 for 4 almost empty boxes. C/O [REDACTED] cannot be trusted, he mishandled my property in 2012 and it cost me \$40. I need my legal work, I have 5 active cases in the federal courts, and I'm asking to be allowed to pack and label my own property in a holding cell. SUGGESTED REMEDY: Allow me to have all my property (which is books, IMU hygiene, papers, photos, legal work, and 1 pair of shoes) in an IMU S holding cell to search for legal work, search for missing items, pack & lable my boxes. PART B - LEVEL II RESPONSE / PARTE B - RESPUESTA 2DO NIVEL

IMU South Manager [REDACTED] has reviewed the Level 1 response and investigated your Level 2 appeal. The following is a summary of his findings: I met with you on 4/30/13 to discuss your grievance. You have 2 boxes of property in long-term storage and 3 boxes in IMU South. The IMU South property officer will work with you to sort through the 3 boxes in IMU. You will be allowed to keep one box in your cell, one box in the IMU property storage area and one box will be filled with items you wish to destroy or items that you and the property officer disagree on. This box will be reviewed by me. An inventory of the 2 boxes in long-term storage will be provided to you. We also discussed the process for donating books and I agreed to get information to you regarding this process after you receive a copy of your property inventory.
