

Available Activities in the Intensive Management Unit.

1. 3 - Ten Minute Showers per week.
 2. Out-of-cell recreation - 5 times per week. (1 hr ea. d)
 3. Receive 1st class mail, publications, books, photos.
 4. No-contact visits with immediate Family Members (1 hr. Lvl 2 - 2 hrs. Lvl 3 - 3 hrs. Lvl 4)
 5. Radio/Television privileges earned after 60-90 days good behavior, (e.g. Follow Instructions, positive attitude, cell cleanliness, good personal hygiene practices)
- * Educational/GED Programs available upon request and assignment. Correspondence Courses also available provided they meet DOC Policy.

Religious, Self-Help, Mental Health, and Educational Books Available through Library, counselors Administrative, and Outside Resources.

- * Legal Documents/Paperwork must be approved by Classification Counselor through verifiable pending court case(s). Legal Publications are available through Facility Law Library. (must fill out Request Form). Legal Materials are provided on a first come, first serve basis. Forms (Civil Rights Complaint, Habeas Corpus, Tort Claim) are available upon request.

Personal Property is limited to what is received through approved correspondence, store (see list), etc. The following items are approved for offender retention while housed in IMU:

- : Eyeglasses (Rx only); Wedding Band; Address Book; Up to two books from outside publisher; Medications approved by Unit Manager; Approved religious, legal materials.
- Reasons For Placement In IMU vary From (S)ecurity (T)hreat (G)roup involvement and acts of violence, to Multiple guilty Findings of Serious Infractions.

Length/Duration of stay in IMU is averaged at 9 months. Awaiting Intensive Management status Finalization From Headquarters in Olympia, WA, is a necessary part of the process after being recommended For an IMS Program.

Upon Completion of the service of any sanction time received For an infraction, Classification May recommend a Custody demotion to Max Custody if it is determined the offender poses a security/safety risk to General Population, or if the offender's Custody Score was already at a "Close" Custody Level and further restrictions were deemed necessary.

To be released From an IMS Assignment, offenders Must Meet certain expectations, including completing cognitive behavior change courses, Maintaining positive staff interaction, and staying infraction-free.

- All offender escorts/Movements are controlled, and maintained by chained restraints. Wrist are cuffed at all times
