... This is the worse case of abuse I have ever come across." Upon hearing this, I walked into my office and called the work change Officer. I asked the Officer to please remove Inmate Rodgers from my class. Very soon there after, two officers entered my classroom and removed Inmate Rodgers from the classroom.

Inmate Rodgers has stated that he is not willing to cooperate in ABE III due to his medical issues. Inmate Rodgers stated that he is not willing to comply with directives he receives from his supervisor due to his medical issue. He is a distraction and a disruption to the students who are trying to learn. Inmate Rodgers should be returned to Committee and be unassigned to ABE III.
