CUSTODY SUFFIX.

Inmate Pina (S) appeared before PBSP FAC-D SHU UCC on this date for a 180 Day Review. The Disability and Effective Communication (DEC) System reviewed. Per the DECS S has a Test of Adult Basic Education (TABE) score of 9.6. Review of S's Central File revealed S has a Reading Grade Point (RGPL) of 9.6 per CDCR 128B dated 10/13/2011. No staff assistant was assigned as S speaks English, can comprehend the issues and is not a participant in the Mental Health Services Delivery System (MHSDS). S does not require additional Effective Communication devices. An investigative employee was required. To ensure effective communication Committee utilized simple English spoken slowly & clearly. Committee determined effective communication was achieved, as S reiterated in his own words what was explained, and provided appropriate, substantive responses to questions asked. S asked appropriate questions regarding the information provided.


Committee reviewed S's CDCR 128-C3, Medical Classification Chrono dated 5/27/2011, and determined no Classification action is required at his review. Committee also notes a CDCR 128C-2, Developmental Disability Program (DDP) Screening Results Chrono dated 3/17/2004 indicating, NDD. Also note CDCR 128C, Mental Health Screening Chrono dated 7/13/2006, denoting No level of Care. S does not meet PBSP-SHU exclusionary criteria.

Prior to Committee S was issued a CDCR 128B-1 dated 11/7/2013 that was reviewed by Committee. Committee notes a CDCR 128B-2 dated 11/28/2013 currently in SHU on indeterminate status due to his validation as a member of the Nuestra Familia (NF) Security Threat Group (STG), which is known to be involved in criminal activities which threaten the safety of others and institution security, and this requires continued segregation from the General Population. S does not meet criteria for inactive status as outlined in CCR, Title 15, section 3378(e). The last source document used in the validation process is dated 10/16/2007, indicating recent STG activity, (within six years). S was eligible for Active/Inactive review after 10/3/2013. S was referred to IGI for Active/Inactive Review per ICC dated 4/3/2013 and that review is still pending. **Committee acts to retain PBSP SHU on INDET status based on his validation as an active member of the NF STG.**

The prior CSR action dated 5/8/2013 noted no concerns. Committee reviewed S's C-file and determined that the Integrated Housing Code (IHC) of Reside to Own (RO) is appropriate. SOMS was reviewed and S has No Holds, Warrants or Detainers. S was previously issued a copy of the CDCR Form 128G, Advisement of Expectations, Security Threat Group (STG) on 3/29/2013. S has no cellmate and committee notes the "S" custody suffix has previously been applied. **Committee acts to retain the "S" suffix because S has not successfully completed the compatibility review for double celling in PBSP SHU.** S participated in Committee, acknowledged understanding, and disagreed with Committee action. S asked, "Can I get a phone call?" Committee notified S on Saturday, 11/9/2013, per the "Notice of Serious Illness or Death," form authored by Lt. R. Butcher, S was notified of his Mother's death and given opportunity twice to speak with his family. Both times S refused the monitored phone call. Per OP No. 222, during non-business hours, a Facility L may authorize a telephone call, and "all family emergency telephone calls will be monitored by escorting staff and or the approving supervisor". S was advised of Committee's decision and his right to appeal pursuant to California Code of Regulations, Title 15, Section 3084.8(b)(1)&(2) and that any appeal of Committee's action must be submitted within 30 calendar days of this date, whether he has received the CDCR Form 128G Classification Chrono or not. BPH-SUB #1 is scheduled for 1/2022. Next scheduled Committee will be 4/2014 for an Annual/114D review.
