## COMMISSION COMMENTS

You have served 14 years 8 months of a 35 year 6 month PMR sentence structure for 1st Degree 5 Dang Weapon, Solicit a Child for Prostitution, Child Enticement-Expose Organ, Kidnap/Sieze-conf Imprisonment, and Theft. These offenses occurred on November 8, 1998, and involved accosting : on the street, and pulling her into an alley by her pony tail. The victim was told she was going to he you, and a weapon was implied and threats to kill. The victim complied with your demands and you She was told you were a "pimp" and she was to be your prostitute for an evening. She drove to a li and parked the vehicle, where she was forced to perform fellatio, and then remained in the vehicle She managed to persuade you to let her go the next morning. The theft incident occurred earlier o sexual assault, and involved taking a jacket from someone on the same street where the sexual as accosted. Throughout the prosecution of this case, as well as today, you have denied involvement kidnapping. However, as reiterated today, you have been convicted of this offense and therefore, t reviews the case as convicted. At the time of this offense, you had a prior record dating back to 19 through 1998, spanning the states of SC, IA, FL, and WI. The record reflects arrests for property, a as well as, financial and alcohol related offenses. This is your 2nd incarceration, 1st in the state of this incarceration, conduct has been problematic for a number of years with 19 major conduct repo misconduct involving threats, battery, disobeying orders, disruptive conduct, and fighting. This mis extended your mandatory release date by 1 year and 2 months. You served you incarceration to d security. You have been classified at WSPF since a 2003 after a conduct report for battery and ma weapon. The most recent misconduct was acquired in Feb 2012 and involved disobeying orders a credit, you have remained free of major reports since that time; however, needless to say conduct i As far as programming is concerned, there are unmet program needs of AODA, CGIP, SO2, and A Given the PMR status of your sentence, success in recommended programming is essential in con-Reports indicate you originally refused three of the four programs; however, you expressed an inte these in the future. Regardless, these programs are unavailable at the current security level and the through reduced security is necessary before further consideration for programming. Residence pl development as you reported no correspondence with any family. This will require agent assistance timeframe appropriate. In the meantime, considering the severity of the offense, more time is warr. encouraged to consider the steps necessary to work on reducing your risk for an opportunity to trai Those efforts include improved conduct, productive use of your time, taking advantage of opportun motivation for programming.
