WHEN EVER IT RAINS OR THERE IS STRONG WINDS, THE DAMN POWER GOES OUT. THERE IS ALSO THE PROBLEMS WITH THE WATER. CONSTANTLY THE WATER IS CUT OFF FOR ONE REASON OR OTHER.

I'VE SEEN THE WATER COME OUT DARK BROWN, AND WE HAVE TO GO WITHOUT WATER FOR DAYS.

THIS IS THE MOST EXPENSIVE PIECE OF CRAP I'VE EVER BEEN IN. THEY SPENT LIKE 250 MILLION DOLLARS TO BUILD IT, AND FROM DAY ONE THEY'VE HAD PROBLEMS.

I REMEMBER HOW ALL THE DOORS IN UNITS STARTED OPENING, INSTEAD OF JUST THE CELL DOOR THEY WANTED TO OPEN. THIS CAUSED A LOT OF FIGHTS AND ASSAULTS, IT GOT SO BAD THAT THEY HAD TO RE-DO THE ENTIRE SHU DOOR LOCKS.
