I've been over here about 24 hours on Disciplinary Confinement, and it's taking a mental toll on me being confined to this cage, surrounded by inmates who are mentally ill. Randall Jones I've known him for about 20 years, he's not faking, I witnessed him in the past 14 years decline more and more. And there's no way the state of Florida can legally execute him! "No way!"

And here's the thing, the state of Florida is housing Jones here on death row in what is the most expensive housing in the prison system. So his judge, the state attorney, and District Attorney Pam Bondi are wasting tax dollars to confine a mentally ill inmate, to a 9x7... 63 square foot cage here on Florida's death row, and they can never legally execute him.

But Jones isn't the only one, no there's about 20 plus inmates here on the row that the state can never legally kill, instead of reducing their sentence to life, and putting them into housing for the mentally ill, these judges, prosecutors and D.A's are keeping the mentally ill here in the most expensive housing. as well as keeping them in the courts which is running up unnecessary legal bills that the tax payer is paying for. This is waste beyond waste.

I'm here in cell P-4111, I have Jones in cell P4110, and then another inmate 3 cells down in P-4114 whose also mentally gone. Gary McCray I think, and I've been around him before and he's not faking, He's always down here in

a D.C. cell with little to no propriety, and he talks to himself and cuses. IF some one was doing this for weeks or months, that would be one thing, but we're talking years of sitting here rambling about insanity." And they are running me crazy! This is playing with my sanity!!" This is cruel and unusual punishment, being housed around mentally ill inmates!" 30 Plus days of this... I just don't know about that. 24 hours and I'm on the edge. Help me!!" insanity!!" I'm surrounded by it! It's every where!" madness I say!" Complete madness!" only in America's prisons. I wrote Jones judge and informed him that he needs to take action, getting Jones a mental health evaluation ect ect. Hopefully he will take this serious. For now - all I can do, is endure this madness. Pray for me, I need it.
