Sadly Mike S., family got turned away because a ten (10) year old boy was wearing sweatpants. Mike and his family are trying to build bridges and heal wounds but the DOC is against that. They rely on the burnt bridges and festering wounds to ensure job security. Pray for Mike and his family, but curse the guards that turned away a ten (10) year old boy! (It was the super hate filled guard CO Wiff [a woman] and just one "wiff" of her you can smell the hatred!) Thanx to all of our extended family (volunteers included) who made this Mass such a great success and Thanks Be To God!!

CURE-ARM, Inc. has made some great progress in some of its efforts. We received an AWESOME support letter from a Professor at the University of California, San Marcos, and we are expecting another one (say your prayers) from one of her associates at the University of Michigan. These support letters are for our Drama Therapy Group proposal. You can read the actual proposal on this blog at; Drama Therapy Group "A Proposal". We have reached out to as many experts in the use of the Drama Therapy Model as possible and when we have mustered the appropriate support we will submit the proposal formally to the DOC. As anything new and from prisoners it will be an uphill battle, but they would certainly be left with egg on their face if they got in the way of this proven tool to reach prisoners who have been resistant to rehabilitation in the past. This "idle prisoner populations" has been identified by the DOC as a demographic that they must work harder to reach, but as with so many of the DOC's mantras it has proven to be only lip service. CURE-ARM actually cares about this portion of the prisoner population and will use the Drama Therapy Group to reach out to them. I'll keep readers posted on the progress.

I am very proud to report that the first segment of the Alpha Program was offered here at MCI Shirley on Friday, March 7, 2014. It had been almost two (2) years since the Our Lady of Guadalupe

Catholic Community has been able to host the Alpha program due to the fact that the prison administration would not open the Chapel on Friday nights. Letter and phone call campaigns, along with a loud outcry from the regular volunteers Jack, Dennis and Mike, broke down the DOC and they finally had to allow the Chapel to be open. Thanks Be To God! During the two (2) year hiatus the volunteers still came each and every week, even though we were jammed into a small classroom rather than our Blessed Chapel. We watched spiritual videos and had productive fellowship, but it just was not the same as the official Alpha Program in our Chapel. It was great to once again hear Reverend Nicky Gumbal give a rousing sermon and then have an organized discussion about the topic. Our prayers are that all the men we lost due to the banishment to the classroom will come back now that we are in the new Chapel. The Alpha Program truly changes lives and we were all fully perplexed as to why the DOC chose not to support it for so long: typical department of corruption job security efforts. Let's be grateful Alpha is back!

THE BAD

Our friend Jerry A., who is dying of liver cancer/Hep C., and was recently given a five (5) year parole set-back by the Devil incarnate Josh Wall, recently had a serious health failing up in Deputy Denied-Oh's "sniff". From all reports (and our spies have given us many this week) Jerry was in real bad shape. He lost control of all his bodily functions, was unresponsive, and had to be rushed to the outside hospital, where he remains, on your dime. Jerry went to this scumbag Walsh's Parole Board seeking a medical parole. He had a solid plan and there was no getting around how sick he is as his pallor is sallow, his eyes are yellow, and his abdomen is distended from a swollen liver. Josh Wall ignored all of that and tortured Jerry about d-reports he got for "dirty urines". Jerry has had to self-medicate due to the inadequate pain treatment regime of the "sniff" staff and medical services. This is outrageous and is an unsanctioned tax upon our friends and family. These "hidden" costs are a criminal act: it is close to extortion (and who is surprised as these M-Fer's are the real crooks), but it also diminishes public safety as men/women in prison cannot use the phones to rebuild family ties and build a foundation for release as it is too expensive due to hiddens fees and bogus DOC contracts. It's too bad our so called "advocates" at Prison Legal Services are dropping the ball on their litigation on this topic (they have been litigating phone rates here since at least 2009), but I have some real good news that a very competent jailhouse lawyer (he is actually an MBA from Columbia University) is taking on GTL and the DOC as far as phone rates are concerned. I don't know where Leslie W., got her degree (probably from I Can't Help U.) but I am confident that this Columbia grad will prevail. Thank God for the prisoners who have the guts to actually litigate against these bastards: at great personal risk. May Deputy DiNardo will have to call someone who gives a F&*%! (She won't be charged any "fees")
