

Nate's News - 11 March 2014

I'm back in the S.H.U. (Special Housing Unit), have been since 7 Jan. At first I was told that it was b/c something in my state P.S.I. (Pre-sentence Investigation) Report was "bad" (Special Investigation Services - S.I.S. - officer Hicks said it appeared I'd ratted on my brother for our homicide - actually, it's the other way around...) & that some inmates brought it to his attention, said I was gonna get hit (that would never happen; I'd just get hit); S.I.S. Hicks told my bro on the yard that I could not be let out because he was getting kites that said I was gonna get smashed due to a case. I filed in WI, so couldn't be let out of S.H.U. Finally, I asked S.I.A. ("A" for Agent, an F.B.I. liason) Heath, Hicks supervisor, why I'm being kept in S.H.U. & Heath said it's because he got word from my own bros that I was not in good standing, was gonna get hit - which, also, is incredible.

If anyone told staff I was gonna get hit if not removed from the yard, I don't take that threat seriously. But, I've learned such is a common practice, known as "kiting someone off the yard." I f-ing hope no bro. of mine would do such a passified move - but one can never tell in prison. I am against using & selling dope & let my bros know so as soon as I stepped in.

Coincidentally, I was put in S.H.U. the day after I put my last postings for this blog out in the mail. It's possible what I wrote tugged at the cop-strings of "correctional" staff here, who, like in WI, make their money, feed their offspring by pretending to try & rehabilitate people while, generally, doing the opposite.

There's less insanity in the SHU here. Maybe, probably, because the conditions are not entirely barren. We can have a radio with batteries, magazines, newspapers, and get more food than is given in W.C.I.'s seg. unit.

I was told I'll be transferred, maybe to another state's prison system. I can't help but wonder if WI's D.O.C. is behind this, because I finally received my legal papers & have been at their asses in court, including winning my petition in Appeal No. 2013AP2695-W - look it up on wicourts.gov
