Monday March 17, 2014 6:03 am

Just finished washing up and cleaning up. I'm tired. Did not get a good night's sleep. Officers came through last night deliberately making noise to wake us up. Oh well, I'm going to eat here in a few minutes, and then decide what I will write. Maybe do some reading first.

7:00 am. Trying to get motivated. I'm just so tired. Waiting on legal mail. Got these two letters going out to attorney's, trying to get the death penalty abolished. I have one grievance going in about these cell lights and wasting electricity back here in the DC cells by not putting in light switches. Have ten empty cells right now, that the lights will be on 18 1/2 hours a day, just wasting energy and money. DC cells at FSP, have light switches.

7:38 am. Just finished a short letter to an org. Legal mail was picked up about 20 minutes ago. Guess I'll walk for a while.

7:40 am. They just come by calling rec. they won't let me go until I'm down here 30 days which is not a rule. I'm currently challenging

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it in a grievance. I haven't been out of this cage in 17 days. Time to walk.

8:28am. Just been walking. Going to eat a PB&J sandwich and a one ounce bowl of corn flakes here in a minute. That's what I get for breakfast every morning. Wish I could order canteen down here.

I'd like to get a couple of packs of cookies to give McCray. He drives me crazy, but I feel so sorry for him. I bet he's never had any canteen. Even if someone sent him money, he wouldn't know how to order. He has nothing in his cell other than mattress blanket, sheets


orange clothes and his under wear and shower slides, which just broke the other day. I'm going to try to order a new pair for him. That is something I'm allowed to order down here.

He shouldn't be left in there like that. He needs to be in a mental ward, not a death row cell! And not like that!" society is brutal!" Robert Henry is sitting over there with 3 days left to live. about 81 hours left, to think about his life, and his death 81 hours to take it all in. 81 hours to live. We are a very sick nation. Kill 'em all and let God sort them out!" Through out compassion, mercy forgiveness.

just kill! Kill! Kill! Got to be a better way. makes me sick thinking about Henry's death. Need to walk.

9:06am. Just wrote a grievance trying to get Fari back for us guys on DC. Time to eat.

9:23am. Ate, washed the floor down. Now



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got to figure out what to do next. I can hear Randall Jones down there in cell 4102 talking to his self. He's mentally burned up. I remember in 2000, he started going down hill, and he's at the bottom of the hill, and there's nothing left up in the air. And there was no reason to put him in that closed in cell. He writes and says a lot out of his mouth, but he's harmless. I seen a little guy on the yard threaten him, and he wouldn't do anything. Again he should be in a mental ward not death row.

11:44am. Wrote a letter to mom. and hooked up some other stuff. They brought lunch it's sardines. I'll eat later. I've got to get back to work on this project.

1:02PM. It's pouring down rain, and the officers are pulling rec. Wish I could go out. They didn't pull rec this morning because of restricted movement. I was just talking with Troy about these execution's, and what needs to be done to abolish it. We're working together on this, although we fought and could fight again. We still have the same goal to reach, abolishment of Capital punishment. Going to walk for a while, then write or read.

3:12PM. Wrote a short letter, and then did some reading. Washed some clothes that's going to take forever to dry. waiting on dinner, shower's then bed and hopefully some mail tonight.

4:03PM. Been reading, waiting on dinner.

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should be here any time. I know it's here I
heard them serving up stairs.

4:28 P.M. just finished eating. Processed chicken sliced
potatoes and mixed veges and one slice of bread.
Not that big of a meal.

5:53 P.M. waiting on showers. Robert Henry has 72 hours
left to live. 72 hours he'll be strapped to the gurney
waiting for the curtain to open, so they can
watch him die.

6:55 P.M. just got back from the shower. Fixing to
lay back do some reading until I go to sleep.

Tuesday March 18, 2014 2:37 A.M. Got up at 5:15 washed
up, cleaned up, and then went to writing these
grievance appeals. Got the responses back last night
for both DRS and who investigates them and types
them up. Classification, Kangaroo Court, Kangaroo
appeal. What can you expect in the dirty south, so
I'm filing the appeal to Tallahassee. Got a card last
night, so I'll respond to that. I did win one
grievance on getting my recreation while I'm down
here. I knew they were violating the rules. I'll be
posting that on the blog for all to read. I'm going
to fix my P-B & J sandwich and read.

7:09 A.M. just finished eating. I'll read for a bit and
then write that letter.

8:38 A.M. finished a letter. Going to walk for a while.

8:50 A.M. Classification officer just come through
picking up grievances, and when she picked mine
up, she said this aint more grievances about

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the website is? I said, It's D.R. Appeals going to Tallahassee, she let out a sigh and rolled her eyes: I had quit Filing grievances, Not any more. They've rubbed me the wrong way. Both of these D.R.s are bogus. Neither should have been written.

10:25am. Been laying here reading. I'm tired, and I could go to sleep. I won't. At 1:30 P.M. I'm suppose to go see the psychologist. Not sure I'll go. From what I see, he seems to be useless and I've been anxious lately. These 2 D.R.s were bogus, and concerned about Further bogus D.R.s

11:31am just finished eating, before that I wrote a letter. I ate sardines.

12:36 P.M. Been walking back and forth talking to Troy. Not sure if I'm going to this call. to the psychologist. see how I feel in another hour.

2:51 P.M. just got back from seeing the psychologist. That's the first time I went out and talked to him. I like him, so I'll go out and see him from time to time. He was 21 minutes late, so I sat out there talking to 2 sqts and a C.O. For 30 minutes or so. Had a good talk, talking about everything from people that have retired, to funny incidences. It was enjoyable. I'm going to do some reading.

4:44 P.M. Finished eating, did not enjoy it. That meat loaf patty. It's just nasty. I hate having to eat that. Just had no choice. Hope for some mail tonight and do some reading until then.

Robert Henry's got just over 49 hours to live.

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6:04 PM, just finished reading some rules, and wrote a request to the Captain, see what they have to say. Fixing to do some reading.

7:03 PM. Going to sleep now. Henry has 47 hours to live.

Wednesday March 19, 2014 6:09 am. Been up about an hour washed up, cleaned up, did some reading got my sheet's ready to go to the laundry. Got three letter's last night, so I need to do some writing need to get some request slips for grievances.

8:53 am. Drafted up a request on these leg irons/shackles. Wrote a letter to my cousin, need to write mom next and go from there. First I'm going to walk for a little bit.

9:44 am. Finished a letter to mom. Going to walk for a few minutes then read.

11:14 am. Finished eating lunch Turkey processed to death mixed veg's and sliced potato's one slice of bread and an orange. Going to walk for a while.

1:07 PM. Been talking to Troy, he's going to take a nap. Was walking and before that reading.

4:08 PM. Waiting on dinner. We got back news on the rent about our diet, their cutting our food down again. Retaliating over judge seitz order trying to make people get off of this diet. I can't survive on what I just heard is on the new menu. This is going to be rough!

4:32 PM. Just finished eating. Was told that until I remove this blog, I'll remain on D.C. so

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time for me to do some writing. we will see about this. Try to turn the pressure up.

6:03 PM. wrote a letter, and did some reading, now just waiting on the shower, after which I'll come back do some reading and go to sleep. Hope to get woke up with some mail. Poor Henry is sitting over there with 24 hours left. It would be more compassionate to just walk up and kill him, rather than make him sit and count down the hours.

7:24 PM. just got back from the shower. Fix'n to lay down read and call it a day.

Thursday March 20, 2014 5:57 am. Henry has 12 hours to live. Woke up thinking about him. I've been up since 4:16. Didn't get out of bed until 5:10 when they turned the lights on. I washed up, cleaned the cell made the bunk, and now I'm making my breakfast and will do some reading.

7:27 am. just found out Robert Mindrix got his death warrant signed yesterday. on D.C. it's hard to find out anything. I hate hearing that another warrant is signed. I've known Big Rob for almost 20 years. met him in Oct. 94. never been close. still didn't like this news.

12:20 PM. Been reading, wrote mom, ate some sardines for lunch. Getting burned out on these sardines, and there fixing to be a regular dinner meal starting next Monday.

1:29 PM. was reading. still need to finish this

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letter to mom. I'm tired. Wish I had something to do that could pass some time. Lost my art supplies, so no longer have that to pass time. I think I'll lay down for a bit.

2:56 PM. Robert Henry has just over 3 hours to live, unless he gets a stay.

4:04 PM. Waiting on dinner, as Henry waits to die. Two hours left to live. What's he thinking as he counts off the last minutes of his life?

4:36 PM. They served dinner. I'll eat here in a few minutes. I'm going to put some sardines in a soup, and that'll be my dinner.

5:41 PM. Just sitting here thinking of Henry. Big Rob will be on the back side, they probably didn't even see each other. Henry would be on his last phase and Big Rob would be on the other side just starting his phase. Maybe something will happen and he will get a stay. No way to find out back here on DC, and this

McCray is saying over and over again, we're screwed. Robert Henry I was just thinking had just got a new pair of shoes back in Dec or January. First new pair he's had as long as I've known him. It was nice to see him get something new, and have some money. I use to give him my shoes before I'd wear them out.

6:00 PM. Just sitting here thinking about Henry. I'm going to miss him. He was a good guy. I don't know about his crime, but he was not the same person they sentenced to death. I'm fixing to lay down and read and try to sleep.

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Friday March 21, 2014 5:22am. Cleaned up made the bunk, breakfast will be here in about 3 minutes or less it's behind us. I got a letter from Anne last night with Henry's last statement that he wrote out. I still haven't heard anything on his execution. Here's breakfast.

6:27am. Just filed 2 grievances. Fixing to hook up my PB&J sandwich and eat breakfast.

8:21am. Just finished a letter to Anne, and then prepared Robert L. Henry's last statement to be placed on the blog, want to share it with others. I'm going to walk for a while.

9:21am. Just talked to Classification who just threatened me again, stating "I didn't threaten you the other day." Which she did threaten me with 6 months mail suspension, she said I didn't threaten you, I told you. Now she threatened me with a 60 day DR. Lying to staff because I wrote her up for threatening me with 6 month mail suspension. These were meant in a threatening manner.

11:25am. Well just got lunch, but I'm writing. I'm tired of misconduct, so I'm trying to push people to ask the Florida senate for personalized audio and video cameras for correctional officers and mandatory polygraph test. That'll cut out what just took place this morning.

1:34pm. Been writing letters. Just stopped to talk to the chaplain. I'm turning out some

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letters. I've got to get all the people that I know in Florida to push a bill on mandatory polygraph exams. We need the corruption stopped. Also got confirmation that they killed Henry last night. Little buddies gone. I'm going to walk for a bit and then write some more.

3:20 PM. Just finished another letter. Writing people I haven't written in awhile, trying to build a real support team to fight the death penalty and the corruption here in the FDOC.

4:22 PM just finished eating, wrote another card. Got to write another letter here shortly or maybe tomorrow. I've been writing all day long. My hands hurting. I've got to implement change. All this corruption, I need it to end once and for all.

5:01 PM. Just finished washing clothes, waiting on the shower and then bed. First thing tomorrow morning I'll get to writing. In fact I'm going to write a legal letter now.

6:50 PM. Just got back from the shower, going to write a letter.

7:32 PM. Finished a legal letter fixing to lay down.

Saturday March 22, 2014 6:03 am. Got up at 5 cleaned up made the bunk, read the letters I received last night. Now time to do some writing.

8:46 am. Wrote 2 letters. I've got some major plans to bring about change. Going to eat now, then do some walking.

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11:25am. just finished a grievance. Lunch came a few minutes ago. I'm fixing to stop and eat, then do some more writing.

2:28pm. wrote an open letter to the court about these diets, then did some reading, which I've got a headache from. Now I'm going to do some walking.

4:31pm. just finished eating butter bread for dinner. I'm tired of Peanutbutter and jelly sandwiches. Been working on a grievance. I've got it drafted up. I'll put it on the form tomorrow.

5:02pm. was just laying down, thinking about life, women that I loved, but what did I know, I was only a 21 year old punk kid. This life has been a mess from start to finish. And it's only right that it'll end in the death chamber in just life, unjust death. Why did life have to take such a rough path? It's been a mess. Heart filed with pain. Got too much time to think.

5:54pm. went ahead and wrote this grievance out. probably won't matter. I'll wind up with DR's this week. That's if she meant what she said about her latest threat.

6:17pm. just wrote another grievance and I'm calling it a day. Time to lay down.

Sunday March 23, 2014 5:56am. Been up since 4am. Couldn't do anything, the lights don't come on until 5am. Not even sure what I'm going to do today. May write a grievance a letter or two. Need to write a couple of legal

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letters, and that's what I'll do this morning.

6:39am. Just finished a letter to the ACLU. Going to eat my PB&J sandwich and cereal now.

10:28am. Just finished writing now another letter. Going to walk for a while and wait on lunch.

11:34am. Just finished eating lunch. Processed chicken patty, diced potatoes and mixed veges. Guess I'll walk for a while then try to figure out what to do next.

12:44 PM. Just spent the last couple of hours writing the Florida House of Representative's about a House Bill to improve the FDOC.

2:46 PM. Just been reading. Got an zip date on the March Madness basketball games.

4:06 PM. Tried to eat this meal, it was just so nasty. Heard that was true, that the witnesses who watched Robert Henry be killed, chanted "Die! Die! Die!" as he was being put to death.

sound's like crowds at an arena back in the gladiator days, enjoying the kill, the thirst for death. Only in 21st century America, do we have insane people, citizens, chanting for a human being to die. Blood thirsty evil people!! "Die! Die! Die!" What's wrong with them that they would even consider doing such a thing. Knowing Henry's friend or family is sitting in that same room, suffering the loss of their loved one whose being put to death in front of their very eyes.

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And you chant Die! Die! Die! Their sick!
5:09 PM. Been sitting here talking to Troy about the
prison system, and change that needs to happen.
But probably never will. I'm going to do some read-
ing and then probably go to sleep.

6:30 PM. Been reading, but about to call it a day
and hit the bed, think of a life that never
was, better times that could have been, and
escape this loneliness through my sleep. Yes one
more day here in disciplinary confinement on
Florida's death row. This is my existence day
in and day out. Welcome to my world.
