8:57 am. Wrote 2 cards. I need to write a letter, a friend of mine's getting a media interview, and I want to see if they want to interview me.

11:48 am. Just ate a beef stew and beans and rice for lunch. So far they haven't called us for rec. Not sure what I'll do this afternoon. I've been looking back at these photos. Seems like a different life. Wish I could go back and do it all differently.

1:23 PM. It's pouring rain. Rec was called for

the North side. They will call us tomorrow. I spoke with the captain about the law library, and he's changing the way it's run, back to like it was before the last warden messed it up.

4:51 PM. I tried taking a nap, and every time I dozed off, someone called me. I ate lunch for dinner with the tomatoes and beans. Fixing to watch the news, and then go to bed.

6:27 am. Going to bed.

Friday May 2, 2014 7:09 am. Been up since 5 am. Made the bunk, cleaned the cell, and got everything ready for rec. I wasn't going to go, it's been raining hard, but I need out of this cage. In fact they just called rec.

7:53 AM. I didn't go out, I got paranoid, someone called up stairs and said RC (me) that I'm going out. That never happened before. Then the officers come down and tried really hard to get me to go out, so it didn't feel right, something's up. or maybe I'm just paranoid, but I don't think so. I don't like this.

8:19 am. They just came through and told chip to pack it up. he's being moved up stairs. We think they need this cell down here, for a guy that's getting off D.C. who has to be down here for medical.

9:38 am. chips gone and this spanish

guy with medical problems was put in cell
8120. I've known him for several years.

11:49am. Got back from the law library at 11:15
Ate my lunch, soup and beans. Glad I didn't
go to the yard, it rained and I would have
missed this law library call out.

2:18 PM. at 1 PM. they said Father Conrad was
here to see me, so I had to hurry up and
get ready, just got back. I have a nice time
talking with him. This morning, I think I just
got paranoid. Find out this next week if some-
thing goes down.

4:21 PM. Had beef stew and beans for dinner. Now
waiting on the showers and then bed. Hate that
chip got moved. I like chip. He's been down
here on this floor for about 3 years.

5:46 PM. The van just came in, no doubt a warr-
ant just got signed. We had also heard the col.
is in the building. Need to try to find out
who it is.

6:01 PM. The van just left. Some ones on their
way to F.S.P. Now got to find out who it is.

7:24 PM. just got back from the shower. Found out it
was John Henry who got his death warrant signed. He's
been on the row for 22 years. I'm going to bed now.

SATURDAY May 3, 2014 6:19 am. Got my sheets in
the sink soaking. Need to get them washed and
wash some other clothes this morning. I
didn't get any mail last night. Guess I'll

write a couple of grievances today. Not sure what else I'll do. Maybe some art.

7:03am Got the first sheet and pillow case washed and rinsed and drying. The others soaking in the sink.

7:41am wrote two grievances, one on the ink pens the other on the fact we should be getting at least two hot meals a day per 33-204.003 (1) so their violating that.

8:34am. Finished washing clothes, now got to get them to dry. and right now the Col is in the building. wrote the medical grievance appeal.

11:19am sheets are still wet. it's raining and that's not helping with these drying. I made some burritos for lunch, they were only okay. Fixing to make a cup of coffee and see what's on TV. if nothing good is on, then I'll probably do some art work.

2:24 P.M. sheets are all dry, still drying t-shirts. I've been doing art work, while watching NASCAR. I need to wash towels, and the clothes I'm wearing and get back to this piece of art.

3:47 P.M. just finished two more grievances one on a stand your ground/self defense 33-FAC the other on me being able to sell my art and earn money so I don't have to beg friends and family for money.

6:20 P.M. Ate beans and sardines for dinner. Been working on some art. I'm fixing to lay down and go to sleep. I'm really tired, it's been a long day.

8:23 am. Just sitting here watching GMA waiting on them to come get me.

2:46 pm. Back from the visit. Had a good one. Going to watch the race and basketball. Don't know when they have John Henry set for.

4:32 pm. Just ate beans for dinner. I'm tired of this diet. But the regular diet isn't any better. In fact it's worse cause it comes on dirty food trays and is handled by nasty inmates.

6:40 pm. Fixing to go to bed and call it a day so tired of being in this cage. This is a rough place to try to survive. Mentally, this cage breaks you down. Would not hurt my feelings to lay down tonight, and never wake again. Oh, how I've prayed for that to happen. Just not that fortunate. Maybe tonight? Nope, won't happen, not that lucky.
