I'm grieving the response that Mr. Davis gave on a request slip that I sent him on 3/12/14 where he responds on 3/18/14 and I quote "There is no reason at this time to reconsider your release from D.C. status, you received 23 days for a Fight DR running consecutive to a DR for mail violation 23 days beginning 3-7-14, you have DC time left to be served" In quote. The fact is the ICT is clearly not following 33-602.222(6)(a) A member of the ICT shall review the cases of inmates in disciplinary confinement every week. The goal shall be toward returning an inmate to open population as soon as the facts of the case indicate that this can be done safely" In quote. So the issue that Mr. Davis addressed stating you have D.C. time left to served, shows that his goal is not to return me to my living quarters

Fact DR# 213-140287 was for a 15 year old website that I requested to be taken down, but it no longer has an owner/operator. For it's been brought to my attention she passed away, so I have no control over WWW.ANGELFIRE.COM and haven't since 2004.

Based on these facts there's no reason why I cannot be returned to a normal (open population) death row cell at this time, for doing so, would not pose an additional security threat, nor further disruption of the orderly operation of this institution, and would not result in further incidence regarding these infractions.
