

Evidence that I Was Transferred Out of the Wisconsin Prison System Due to Exercising My Rights

It's one thing to say that the Powers that Be are conspiring on me, but another thing entirely to be able to prove it. So, attached to this post you'll find all the paperwork related to the decision to send me into federal custody.

What all these documents show (or would show, if you understood how such transfer decisions are usually done) is that:

1) I received a string of false conduct reports (I could further demonstrate the falsity of those disciplinary actions by attaching the records of those proceedings + explaining them to you, but that would weary most readers' patience.... You can obtain these records under WI's open records law, stat. §19.35, et seq.)

2) I was preparing a class-action suit against the prison I was in, concerning widespread abuse of mentally ill prisoners + seeking indictment of culpable staff,

3) Then I was, with unusual quickness and lack of advance notice, shipped off into Federal custody.

4) When I appealed the decision, WI prison officials rejected my appeal on a technicality, mailed the rejection to the wrong address, and I didn't receive it til after the deadline to refile passed.

5) In the B.O.P., I'm denied access to the legal materials I

need to fully litigate my cases — and the WI DOC refuses to remedy this.

These documents reveal more, too. They reveal I have a bad record, which can prejudice people from seeing let alone caring about the fact that I was harassed & then transferred in an attempt to kill the journalism & litigation that I was engaging in in an effort to end the torture of prisoners in WI's prison system.

By the way, I was not a White "supremacist," but a seperatist, yet exhibited solidarity with any abused prisoners, regardless of their race, sexual orientation, etc., as some transexual Black prisoners will verify.

What I was doing should not be deemed extreme — standing up for the fair, humane treatment of prisoners. (See my posts, "... Abuse of Prisoners in W.C.I.'s Segregation Complex," for accurate descriptions of the physical & sexual abuse I'm talking about). It's sad & scary to me that that would be so offensive that WI would kick me all out of its prison system, into the most dangerous prison system in America. That's a lot of power they misused against an extraordinarily powerless person, a powerless person simply seeking decency.

Should any of you want to confirm the legitimacy of these documents or dig yet deeper (e.g. obtain the disciplinary records), you have my permission to do so (provide a copy of this post to the D.O.C.). Journalists may contact me at ph. 352-689-6000. My counsellor is Mr. Coriano.

 On 12/10/12, rec'd 360 days D Sep for battery. Inmate pushed against the trap that was being opened and in the process the officer's hand got slammed by the trap door.
 On 12/19/12, rec'd 360 days program seg for Battery & Misuse of Prescription Meds. The inmate squirted and unknown liquid on an officer, hitting his stomach, groin, and leg areas.
 On 2/19/12, rec'd 45 days Loss of Rec (LOR) for Institution Policies & Procedures. This conduct report was not available to writer.
 On 2/19/12, rec'd 60 days LOR for Disobeying Orders.
 On 4/11/13, rec'd 180 days D Sep for Disrespect & Disruptive Conduct. Inmate made disrespectful comments to a female staff, loudly enough to be heard on the range. — an insulting lie.
 On 8/6/13, rec'd 180 days D Sep for Disrespect. Made insulting and profane comments to an officer about why they deserved to have piss and shit thrown on them is because they are pigs.

discovered by an officer on an inmate coming back from showers. The envelope was an inmate complaint. Upon watching the video of the shower area, they were able to determine that the subject passed the envelope to the inmate who had it in his possession at the time of discovery.

On 8/19/13, rec'd 270 days D Sep for Attempted Group Resistance & Petitions & Disobeying Orders. During the time of dinner trays being picked up, the officer heard the subject yell very loudly to the other inmates to not give their dinner trays back. — yet another lie.

On 9/5/13, rec'd 180 days D Sep for Disrespect. During 1st shift, the inmate told an officer to pick up his mail. The officer reminded the subject that mail gets picked up on 2nd shift. The subject then said to the officer, "Why are you such a fag?" As the officer walked away, the inmate yelled, "Hey Sgt, how long have you been sucking cock; how long have you been taking it in the ass you fucking faggot." — a lie.

To date, he has received a total of 21 minors and 46 majors since his reception (3/3/98).

He has committed the following offenses/received charges for the following: escape, battery, and group resistance & Petitions (gang affiliated/identified--White Supremecist).

Staff Appraisal and Recommendations (Pre-Hearing) Recommend max/WCI due to overall high risk rating, just received at WCI from WSPF on 1/4/13. He was housed at WSPF from 2/9/01 until 1/4/13, and was in segregation for most if not all of that time. He continues to accumulate major conduct reports here also. At the time of this dictation, his anticipated release to G.P from segregation is 6/16/14 but that does not take into consideration any pending majors that have not been heard yet. He is serving a Life Sentence with a PED of 3/3/48. He remains on the Wait List for CGIP, which can be met here at WCI. The inmate had originally been scheduled to start the seg CGIP in September 2013, but at the last minute someone else had to be added instead. He is strongly encouraged to take advantage of any/all opportunities to participate in groups, self-help materials, using PSU as a source for learning appropriate coping skills, and goal-setting. He has questions about how the IGA process works and will direct them to Mr. Heise in Central Office. — *lies. I requested to stay, period. I wanted to know why they were sending me out.*

Committee Comments

Mr. Lindell has been reviewed for Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA) placement. We have received notification he has been accepted.

Admitted in 1998, he has served 16 years since admission. He is serving a LIFE sentence. PED is 3/3/2048.

He rates high on the current risk assessment tool. The inmate has received a total of 47 major conduct reports since admission and is currently in Segregation. The last major CR was 11/26/2013, 360 DS, 303.271 (Lying about Staff). Description of the CR was not available to the Committee.

Program needs are Voc Ed-optional, CGIP 1&2, AM-withdrew, and AODA Residential. Pre-release curriculum is coded wait list; timeframe premature.

No pending charges or ECRB issues. No health or other service needs are noted. Escape Hx: 3/94 & 11/94 LaCrosse CJ.

Mr. Lindell's request is not supported. The Committee concurs with the SW regarding custody; however, we support the IGA acceptance.

The Committee unanimously recommends MAXIMUM custody at DCI/temp OOS. Offense severity, history, time served, significant time remaining to serve, poor institution adjustment, and program needs support recommendation.

He is encouraged to improve institution adjustment and participate in programs.

Release area is 814. A 12 month recall is set (12/14). Not legally eligible for ERP/CIP - excluded offense.

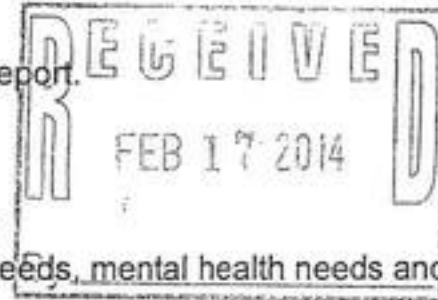

 1) I never dropped out of Anger mgmt. at WSPF. I completed it, two times + still have the certificates of completion.
 in "Hearing" section
 2) I never requested to "eventually like placement with the feds." This was sprung on me, a total surprise. They just told me I'm going like the decision had been made already.
 3) I am in a program, a trauma group, meant to help me with P.T.S.D. This is the first time in my 16 yrs. in prison that I've been offered help with my P.T.S.D., which I so obviously have & had since a child.

Argument

Facts Currently I have an appeal pending in state court, 2 civil rights actions pending in the W.D. Wis. (f.y.i. staff here put the 6 Nov. 2013 orders from the court for these cases in a storage room, didn't give em to me til Thanksgiving day. The orders gave me a 5 Dec. deadline, & the letter I sent to the court that night, Thanksgiving, wasn't mailed, but was returned to me 6 days later saying no to disbursement request for postage was attached, making me miss the deadline - a \$10 disk for postage was attached, I filed a grievance (no), just filed a 3rd in the W.D. Wis. & have a 4th in the E.D. Wis., at the cusp of appealing it. I'm also helping multiple other prisoners here file & litigate civil-rights suits against WDOC staff (Continue ->)

for staff's severe physical + sexual abuse of them, as well as pursuing my own petition for a supervisory writ regarding a John Doe Petition that seeks the indictment of WCI's Admin. for breaching chronic sexual + physical abuse of prisoners here, which I've also published articles about, describing in detail. All of this litigation + journalism I have a right + a duty to do to keep America right. ~~All of this litigation + journalism I have a right~~

Now, finally I'm getting help with PTSD + somebody's deciding to send me the Devil knows where, apparently due to my above activities.

WCI's Admin. tried to intimidate me from exercising the above right (+ duties) by giving me ticket after ticket, allowing Cpt. O'Donovan, the husband of Linda, whom I've sued before, to repeatedly find me guilty with no evidence (the latest lying C.R.) or contrary to the evidence (the group resistance C.R.). For the last C.R., the security director Meli accused me of lying about Cpt. Olson in a PREA complaint (aren't they confidential) I phoned in about C.O. II Schouten, I never mentioned Cpt. Olson, but was found guilty + given a 360 for lying about him, even though Meli admitted at the hearing that he never reviewed the complaint, nor knew what it said. It's obvious that WCI's Admin. is, at least, treating me unfairly, framing me to keep me in seg.

This begs the question - why's M. Heise suddenly approving an I.G.A.?

Transferring me out of the WDOC will moot much of my litigation, thus allowing WCI + other staff to persist in their unconstitutional practices.

It is well known that transferring me due to helping others with litigation or due to my own litigation is unconstitutional. See Buisse v. Hudkins, 584 F.2d 223, 231 (7th Cir 1978). The timing indicates that this is precisely what's in the works, as does the total surprise of the matter. I only went to the hearing because I wanted to ensure I stay here + that's the first I heard of the I.G.A.

Lastly, what's being done to ensure my health + safety + that I get my P.T.S.D. treated in the other system? What about programs I'm required to do. I do have some family in MN, but no longer in WA, TX, etc.

Where exactly do you want to send me + why now?

What property am I allowed?

When, about, will I be taken?

 - g. WI Administrative Code 302

Copies of these resources have been sent to Krista L. Klett, Attorney Advisor for Federal Bureau of Prisons - FCC Allenwood. Ms. Klett has advised that she will ensure your access to these resources.

3. Access to the courts continues to be available to you via U.S. Mail.
4. You are referred to appeal procedures in WI Administrative Code 303 concerning your allegations of a "blatantly false" conduct report.
5. Transfer of personal property is restricted when an inmate is transferred pursuant to an Intergovernmental Agreement (IGA). Property currently held in storage by WI DOC will be processed pursuant to WI Administrative Code and DOC property policies.
