As for visits, everything is back to normal, you could come anytime you wanted. Broad River only has Saturday and Sunday visits though, no Fridays right now. We could get a new picture made of us ... I'd like that. You and my grandmother could ride down sometime maybe, she still asks me about you from time to time.

On the subject of this blog, sometimes I get the comment in less than two weeks, and at other times it can take 90 days since random mail here is sometimes sent to the CRC, Correspondence Review Committee (they check over mail to ensure there is no security issue with mail that the local prison mail staff are unsure of, and internet material is one of the things they review a good bit. Policy and law allows us up to 5 pages of internet material per envelope.). Sometimes, the mail just goes missing.... But, I assure you I'll write when I can, and I am aware of the comment.
