Because of the overwhelming demand for our services in civil liberties issues, we cannot offer you assistance.

We know that prisoners have great difficulty getting legal help and regret that the ACLU of Florida cannot do more in this area. Unfortunately, we have very few attorneys on staff and must rely on volunteer attorneys in private practice to bring cases on behalf of the ACLU.

We receive thousands of complaints a year from prisoners and are seldom able to provide legal assistance. Any one of these complaints can describe an urgent legal need that would take months of a lawyer's time to investigate and resolve.
