In suffering "excruciating, debilitating back
and knee pain." Doctor LaFontant and Corizon
Inc. is denying me an MRI, and outside medical
services, to save money. And this has been
confirmed by the Nursing staff here at UCI
who informed me that Corizon has cut off
medical treatment to cancer patients. And no
surgeries are authorized, that are non-life
threatening.

The Eighth Amendment prohibits the "unnecessary
and wanton infliction of pain." Estelle v. Gamble, 429
U.S. 97, 104 (1976) Now Krugery, Jenne, 164 F. supp ad

vider denied care as a result of a policy to refuse and/or delay treatment to save money stated a deliberate indifference claim against Corporation)

Corizon, by denying me adequate medical treatment to save money is acting with deliberate indifference, and subjecting itself to a law suit.

Doctor LaFontant Falls under Brock v. Wright,
315 F.3d 158, 166 (2d Cir 2003) (Prison's chief medical officer could be held liable for promulgating a policy forbidding treatment of chronically painful keloid.)

I'd prefer treatment, over suing. IF you continue to leave me here suffering with this "excruciating debilitating pain" then I'm going to sue Doctor LaFontant and Corizon medical for proper treatment and money damages. Because the pain and suffering that I'm enduring is uncalled for.

I need the following 1.) An MRI. 2.) surgery upon the MRI's findings. 3.) An extra mattress and bed board to help me sleep. 4.) A heating pad or hot water bottle for my back. 5.) A pain releaver that does not contain "ACETAMINOPHEN" 6.) A cushion to sit on that will help with the lower back. 7.) A high calcium diet for the osteoarthritis.

See attached Radiology Reports dated 11/15/13, 2/14/14 and 2/28/14 showing degenerate disc disease and osteoarthritis, the soft tissue damage and nerve damage can only be detected through an MRI
