Subject: Retaliatory violations, acts of Reprisal,
Classifications Complicit with 2012
Officer on inmate assault and other
illegal activity here at UCI.

In 2010 I got written permission from the
Prison Administration, to operate a blog, and
promote the blog on other websites. When I
got a new Classification Officer Mary R. Mahoney,
I wrote a request slip to her, informing her
of this, to ensure there would be no issues, or
problems. see attached as [Exhibit (A)] DC6-236
Request Form dated 1/3/11 to Mrs. Mahoney rece-
ived January 5, 2011 and responded to by Mrs. Mahoney
on 1/10/11. This is one of the few request slips
that survived the May 2011 through Oct 2012

retaliation, where my legal documents and files were torn up, and some of which was flushed down the toilet, due to my writings on the blog. Those requests should be in my Doc. Files, for your viewing.

On October 22, 2014 I received DR# 213-141428 see attached as [Exhibit (B)] The prison Administration was aware of this, cellpals.com web site in 2010, before it was posted. And as you see by [Exhibit (A)] Mrs Mary R. Mahoney was made aware of it. Now here it is almost five years later, she writes this retaliatory D.R.

she states that I'm violating 33-210.101 (15) c 1. b Third party Correspondence. see attached as [Exhibit (C)] 33-210.101 (C) 1. a b c and d. This rule, is to ensure that inmates, do not use their correspondence privileges, to deceive the public, and hide the fact that they are inmates. I have not violated this rule. I in no way, shape or form tried to hide the fact that I'm an inmate. Further more, if someone attempts to write me, using Third party Correspondence, it is the responsibility of the mail room, to reject that correspondence, and return it to the sender with a D.C. ? rejection form.

On February 28, 2014, Mrs Mary R. Mahoney wrote another Fraudulent Disciplinary Report DR# 213-140287, for a 15 year old website, that I can't get taken down, that I have no control over, and the former owner/operator is no longer alive. This DR# 213-140287, mail violation, was a bogus DR, that should have never been written. And in April 2014 the

Assistant Warden Rossiter, released me from Disciplinary Confinement, and expunged the D.R. from my record. He stated in an e-mail to my friend Anne B. Gardiner, this D.R. should have never been written.

In March 2014 I stopped talking to Mrs. Mahoney because she verbally threatened me twice and on one occasion, was ranting and raving like a lunatic, after that event where she was threatening to suspend my mail, and threatening me with lying to a staff because of the request I wrote on her about the first threats. So I knew it was best to leave her alone. One of the sergeants also informed me, "you're doing the right thing, she's not stable. I seen her snap on another officer over a bottle of water."

Now in 2011-2012 when they attempted to shut my blog down, I was placed in strip cells, property destroyed, they falsified D.R.s to keep me on D.C. and twice I was assaulted by Correctional Officers in May 2012. During the 2nd assault Sgt. Garza stated "Blog about this" and they began throwing punches, beating me to the ground. I was handcuffed, and shackled unable to defend myself. Through all of this unethical, unlawful conduct, Mrs. Mary R. Mahoney was complicit with these illegal acts. She didn't report this abuse to the I.G. In fact when I told her about it, she said "your lying". I was willing to take a polygraph.

Lately, I've placed up on my blog formal complaints and grievances dealing with

this unethical Classification staff. Also Filed on the mold/mildew which brought in the inspectors, in early October, which union C.I. Failed. so I'm ruffling feathers.

I also have medical problems, back, hip and my knee. I was given a wheel chair pass for a year, by Doctor LaFontant see attached [Exhibit (d)] wheel chair pass dated 7-30-14 unt 7-29-15 above that you will see the wheel chair pass at this time is discontinued. I knew it was discontinued on the 14th of Aug. I wrote warden Andrew for help see attached [Exhibit (e)] Aug 14, 2014 Request responded to on Aug 27. Where warden Andrew calls me a liar, and threatens me with a DR. and states that I have a wheel chair pass. If we turn back to [Exhibit (d)] bottom right hand corner. we see a temporary 30 day wheel chair pass was written on Aug 27, 2014. so I didn't lie, Nurse Groom will confirm that I went two weeks without a wheel chair. And the fact remains, warden Andrews threatened me with a DR. and now I'm sitting here with a DR. that should have never been written.

Now I have to continue, to worry about further acts of reprisal, or possible assault that could be orchestrated, through classifications Mary R. Mahoney or Mrs. Diane Andrews who is under an FDLE investigation, for abusive allegations. I need help and protection from further retaliatory acts that could lead to my death, which is happening in the FDOC quite regularly.

INMATE CLARK CLEARLY POSTS HIMSELF ON THE WEBSITE WITH A PROFILE AND STATES HE HOPES "YOU WILL FOLLOW ME ON MY BLOG AND LEAVE COMMENTS." THIS IS IN VIOLATION OF CHAPTER 33-210.101(15) C.B., THIRD PARTY MAILING SERVICES POSTING OF ADS OR OTHER INFORMATION ON INTERNET SITES. SUBJECT IS BEING CHARGED WITH WITH 9-14, MAIL REGULATION VIOLATIONS.

(a) Addresses of incoming mail: The address of all incoming mail must contain the inmate's committed name, identification number and institutional address. The inmate's dorm and bunk locations are not required. All incoming mail shall contain the return address of the sender. The return address of incoming mail is subject to verification, and incoming mail shall be rejected if the sender or recipient cannot be verified.

(b) Addresses of outgoing mail: The return address of all outgoing mail shall contain the inmate's committed name, identification number, and institutional name and institutional address. The inmate's dorm and bunk locations are not required. No prefix other than inmate, Mr., Ms., Miss, or Mrs. nor any suffix other than Jr., Sr. or Roman numeral such as II or III may be included as part of the committed name in the return address. The institutional name in the return address must be spelled out completely with no abbreviations. All outgoing routine mail will be stamped "mailed from a state correctional institution" by mail room staff.

→ (c) Third party mailing services.

1. Inmates shall not utilize any third party mailing services or engage in any activities that would enable them to engage in correspondence without revealing their status as inmates. Examples of prohibited activities include the following:

a. Placement of ads in magazines, newspapers, or other publications;

→ b. Posting of ads or other information on Internet sites; see [Exhibit (A)] Approval

c. Use of any mailing service that allows the inmate to utilize a non-institutional address and engage in correspondence without revealing his status as an inmate;

d. Any activity or service that does not reveal to potential correspondents the inmate's status as an inmate.

*15826 2. Senders shall not utilize any third party mailing services or engage in any

(a) For 1 month after the transfer or release, all first-class and second-class mail will be returned to the post office within 10 working days of receipt with a forwarding address, if available, and a request will be made to postal authorities to forward. All postage due is the responsibility of the inmate and must be paid in accordance with postage regulations. At the end of the 1-month period, all first-class and second-class routine mail will be returned to the U.S. Postal Service with no attempt to have mail forwarded.

(b) From the date of transfer or release, all routine mail other than first-class and second-class will be returned to the U.S. Postal Department for its disposition.

(17) No postage or writing materials shall be provided to inmates for routine mail except as provided in this subsection. Postage and writing materials shall be provided to any inmate with insufficient funds for mailing 1 first class letter weighing 1 ounce or less each month to be used for mailing 1 first class letter weighing 1 ounce or less each month. Local procedures may be established to require the inmate to request the free postage and writing materials or to establish a specific day of the month for the free letters to be processed.

(18) Inmates shall not utilize hand-made packages or envelopes to send out routine mail. Mail enclosed in such materials will be returned to the inmate without processing.

(19) Outgoing packages and envelopes will not bear any artwork, additional lettering or designs other than the required address and return address.

(20) No packaging other than standard envelopes shall be given to inmates. Incoming mail that includes the following types of packaging shall be rejected and returned to the sender unopened: any envelopes that include metal parts, boxes, padded envelopes, plastic bags, card stock type envelopes (i.e. US Mail Priority or US Mail Express card board type), multi-layer packaging, bubble wrap, packing peanuts, etc.

*15827 (21) Routine mail shall be delivered to the institution or facility by the U.S. Postal Service
