15 On October 25, 2013, Petitioner OTIS LEE RODGERS ("Petitioner") filed a petition
16 for writ of habeas corpus ("petition"). Petitioner challenges work and other requirements of
17 his incarceration as slave labor. Petitioner's allegations are conclusory in nature.
18 Furthermore, as to any specific condition or requirement of his incarceration, Petitioner
19 has failed to demonstrate a pre-filing of exhaustion of administrative remedies. (*Wright v.*
20 *State of California* (2004) 122 Cal. App. 4th 659, 665 [Under state law, exhaustion of
21 available administrative remedies is a jurisdictional prerequisite to resort to the courts].)

22 IT IS HEREBY ORDERED, the petition is denied. Petitioner bears a heavy burden
23 initially to provide facts sufficient to support his claims. (*See, People v. Duvall* (1995) 9
24 Cal. 4th 464, 474.) Conclusory allegations made without explanation and/or reference to
25 reasonably available documentary evidence, will generally not warrant habeas corpus
26 relief. (*Duvall*, 9 Cal. 4th at p. 474.)


27 On its own motion the court extends the time to rule on this petition, finding good
28 cause to do so under California Rules of Court, rule 4.551, subdivision (h) considering the
unusually high number of pending writ petitions, the administrative delay in presentation of
