Re: Coleman Case Abuses

I have been in prison for 18 yrs. now, and I've witnessed a paradigm shift in the CDCR promoting psychiatric "care" which has presented rampant opportunities for manipulation and abuse — all at great cost to tax payers and irrevocably effecting California prisoners.

I have witnessed prisoners utilizing the psych. dept. in order to become classified for CCCMS, as a means of qualifying for Ad-Seq. "accommodations" permitting possession of their T.V.'s, whereas non-CCCMS prisoners would do without their T.V.'s, per policy at the time. I have witnessed prisoners utilizing the psych. dept. in order to become CCCMS and qualify for transfers to more "accommodating" prisons, whereas non-CCCMS prisoners are without any other means to transfer out of the more sever prison programs. I've witnessed EUP prisoners admittedly manipulate their Mental Health claims in order to qualify for the above "accommodations", as well as to secure their ALA privileges/program advantages. And most recently, I've witnessed a profusion of prisoners making Transgender claims these last few years, in order to qualify for hormone therapy and grow breasts — as a means of gaining favor and protection from prison predators and/or drug dealers taking advantage of turning out prison punks.

I would like to make myself available to you, providing this all too often neglected point of view exposing the abuses in CDCR's Mental Health Dept. And if at all possible, I'd like assistance in obtaining the statistics revealing:

- 1- Exponential increase of mental health patients in CDCR circa 1995 to 2015;
- 2- Psych. Dept. budget allocations in CDCR circa 1995 to 2015;
- 3- Psychotropic medication budget allocations in CDCR circa 1995 to 2015;
- 4- Number of Transgender Prisoners in CDCR circa 1995 to 2015; and
- 5- Budget allocations for Transgender Hormone therapy in CDCR circa 1995 to 2015
