Wesley Earl "Wes" Craven was born in Cleveland on Aug. 2, 1939, to a strict Baptist family. He earned a master's degree in philosophy and writing from Johns Hopkins University and briefly taught as a college professor in Pennsylvania and New York, but his start in movies was in pornography, where he worked under pseudonyms.

Craven's feature debut under his own name was 1972's "The Last House on the Left," a horror film inspired by Ingmar Bergman's "The Virgin Spring," about teenage girls abducted and taken into the woods. Made for just \$87,000, the film, though graphic enough to be censored in many countries, was a hit. Roger Ebert said it was "about four times as good as you'd expect."

"Nightmare on Elm Street," however, catapulted Craven to far greater renown in 1984. The Ohio-set film is about teenagers, including a then unknown Johnny Depp, who are stalked in their dreams. Craven wrote and directed, starting a franchise that has carried on, most recently with a 2010 remake.

The concept, Craven said, came from his own youth in Cleveland — specifically an Elm Street cemetery and a homeless man that inspired Krueger's raged look.

Along with John Carpenter's "Halloween," "Nightmare on Elm Street" defined a horror tradition where helpless teenagers are preyed upon by knife-wielding, deformed killers in cruel morality tales. Usually promiscuous girls were the first to go.

"There is something about the American dream, the sort of Disneyesque dream, if you will, of the beautifully trimmed front lawn, the white picket fence, mom and dad and their happy children, God-fearing and doing good whenever they can," Craven once said. "And the flip side of it, the kind of anger and the sense of outrage that comes from discovering that that's not the truth of the matter, that gives American horror films, in some ways, kind of an additional rage."

Director Edgar Wright, who counts Craven as one of his influences, reflected on the legacy of his films in a tribute on his website.

"The first 'Nightmare' quickly became a landmark horror movie and what distinguished it then is what still marks it out as a classic now. It's the sheer twisted imagination of the premise; the idea of lucid waking nightmares bleeding into the real world makes Freddy Krueger a much more formidable and interesting foe than any of his slasher rivals," Wright wrote.

The formula would work again for Craven with "Scream," albeit with an added layer of self-aware spoof. By 1996, the Craven-style slasher was a well-known type, even if it wasn't always made by him. He had no involvement with many of the "Elm Street" sequels.

"Scream," written by Kevin Williamson and starring a cast including Drew Barrymore and Neve Campbell, played off of the horror clichés Craven helped create. It hatched three sequels, all of which Craven directed.

Courtney Cox, who appeared in four of the "Scream" films, said on Twitter that the world had lost a great man, "my friend and mentor, Wes Craven." Her "Scream" co-star Rose McGowan echoed the sentiment, writing that "a giant has left us."

Craven increasingly oversaw a cottage industry of horror branded with his name, including remakes of his 1977 film "The Hills Have Eyes" (2006) and "The Last House on the Left" (2009).

Craven was also a published author (the 2000 novel "The Fountain Society") and an ardent bird conservationist, serving as a long-time member of the Audubon California board of directors. He recently penned a monthly column "Wes Craven's The Birds" for Martha's Vineyard Magazine.

He was active until his death. Craven had numerous television projects in development, including a new "Scream" series for MTV. He was an executive producer of the upcoming film "The Girl in the Photographs," which is to premiere in September at the Toronto International Film Festival.

In a statement, Craven's family said he died in his Los Angeles home, surrounded by family, after battling brain cancer.

He is survived by his wife, producer Iya Labunka, a son, daughter and stepdaughter.

In 2010, he told The Los Angeles Times: "My goal is to die in my 90s on the set, say, 'That's a wrap,' after the last shot, fall over dead and have the grips go out and raise a beer to me."

France train hero is among 'Dancing With the Stars' cast

An American who stopped a potential terrorist attack, controversial celebrity chef Paula Deen and wildlife conservationist Bindi Irwin are among the 13 celebrity dancers competing in the latest season of "Dancing With the Stars," which premieres September 14.

After building up anticipation by releasing several names -- including those of Irwin; teen social media star Hayes Grier; and singers Nick Carter, Chaka Khan and Andy Grammer -- ABC finally announced the full list Wednesday on "Good Morning America."

Army National Guard Spc. Alek Skarlatos, 22, was the biggest reveal Wednesday morning. Just last month, Skarlatos made headlines around the world when he helped prevent a possible terrorist attack on a train in Europe. He was on vacation after a deployment in Afghanistan with Airman 1st Class Spencer Stone and student Anthony Sadler when the three Americans, a

Frenchman and a British national subdued a man with a rifle.

Reality television stars are also representing. Singer and "Braxton Family Values" star Tamar Braxton, who also hosts and produces "The Real," and "Real Housewives of Atlanta" star Kim Zolciak Biermann were announced as celebrity dancers Wednesday morning.

Other celebrity dancers include Academy Award-nominated actor Gary Busey, known for his off-the-wall antics; actor Alexa PenaVega and actor/singer Carlos PenaVega, the first married couple to compete against each other; and jockey Victor Espinoza, who rode American Pharoah this year to the first Triple Crown victory since 1978.

Rumer Willis and professional dancer Valentin Chmerkovskiy won season 20 of "Dancing with the Stars" in May. Willis is the daughter of actors Bruce Willis and Demi Moore. Other season 20 participants included singer-actor Riker Lynch, who came in second, and military veteran Noah Galloway, who came in third. Singer Patti LaBelle, football player Michael Sam and musician RedFoo also competed.

The 49-year-old singer, who last hit the road in 2011 for her Number Ones, Up Close and Personal Tour, opened the concert with a new song *Burn It Up* featuring Missy Elliott, reports E! Online.

Before Jackson took the stage, Elliott tweeted, "Positive vibes to my sis @JanetJackson the opening of her tour 2night! U r UNBREAKABLE. Do ya thang."

The five-time Grammy Award winner performed a mix of her old and new songs during the concert, including *Nasty*, *Feedback*, *Miss You Much* and *You Want This*.

Jason Day overpowers the field, earns win at The Barclays

EDISON, N.J. -- On Wednesday Jason Day couldn't play golf because of a bad back. On Sunday following his latest commanding performance inside the gallery ropes, Day left The Barclays hauling the championship hardware.

Behind his stunning power, crisp iron play and great touch on and around the greens, the Thunder from Down Under took apart Plainfield Country Club and won the first of four events in the FedExCup Playoffs.

Reminiscent of his authoritative three-stroke win in the PGA Championship two weeks ago, where he overpowered Whistling Straits and the field to win his first major, Day gave little hope to his chasers in the final round. In the process, he took the lead away from Jordan Spieth as the lucrative FedExCup Playoffs move to TPC Boston for the Deutsche Bank Championship.

With a flawless 8-under-par 62, Day, who began the day in a tie for the lead with Sangmoon Bae, finished at 19 under and six strokes ahead of Henrik Stenson, whose final-round 66 still left him well behind. Bubba Watson shot 69 to finish third, eight shots back.

"It's been a good summer for me. I never expected to come out and play the way I did today. Just very patient with myself," Day said. "It's been an amazing year for me. Just the work and dedication I've put in over the years, it feels like it's finally paying off. It's been a whirlwind kind of summer."

"I never really got the chance to sit down last week and kind of, you know, go through

what happened at the PGA. ... But it's a lot easier than coming down the stretch in a major championship, I can tell you that."

Day, 27, moved into the lead with a 63 on Saturday, meaning he played his last 36 holes in 15 under. He'll remain No. 3 in the world, behind only No. 1 Rory McIlroy and No. 2 Spieth, who lost the top rank when he missed the cut this week.

"It always is a goal of mine," Day said about getting to No. 1. "I can only control what I can control. I can't control them. Seeing Jordan and Rory are going to play next week, they'll most likely play well. That means I'll have to play well, as well, just to keep this momentum going."

With his second win in as many starts, his third in his last four starts and fourth for the year, Day has at least joined the conversation for player of the year, which seemed like a lock for Spieth considering his four wins, including victories in the Masters and U.S. Open, a tie for fourth in the British Open and a runner-up finish to Day in the PGA.

Day, who also won the Farmers Insurance Open and the RBC Canadian Open when he closed with three birdies to beat Watson by one, finished in a tie for fourth at the British Open and tied for ninth in the U.S. Open.

"It's not easy," chasing down Day, said Zach Johnson, who closed with a 69 to finish in a tie for fourth with Zac Blair (66). "You pretty much have to play flawless golf. You would have liked to have seen someone put pressure on him, but it probably wouldn't have mattered."

It didn't. After Day opened up a 4-stroke lead with birdies at 10 and 11, Stenson closed to within two shots with birdies on 13 and 14. But Day responded with birdies from 28 feet on the 14th and from 33 feet on the 15th. He added another birdie for good measure on the 18th hole.

"He's full of confidence and playing great golf," Stenson said. "He's on top of his game and no one has been better the last couple of months. Spieth was the best the first six months, but now Day has been the best for two months."

Day almost didn't play this week. On Tuesday, Day tweaked his back moving a box under his motor coach. On Wednesday he got an MRI. On Thursday he grabbed his back on a few occasions but fought through the pain. In the final three rounds, he wasn't bothered much by the back, with the New Jersey heat exceeding 90 degrees helping to keep his back loose.

"He has a great mixture of power and touch around the greens and obviously he's putting beautifully right now. That's a pretty good recipe for success," said former world No. 1 Luke Donald. "For a guy who struggled to get over the finish line, he's learned to get over the hump and the floodgates have

opened. He's a very tough guy to beat right now."

Brian Harman makes 2 aces at Barclays

EDISON, N.J. — Brian Harman had pocket aces Sunday in the final round of The Barclays, the first event of the FedExCup Playoffs.

After not making one hole-in-one in the first 1,567 par-3s he played on the PGA Tour, the lefty made two in his next four appearances on a par-3 tee box. Harman's first ace Sunday came on the third hole from 184 yards using a 7-iron, his second from 220 yards on the 14th using a 4-iron hybrid.

"I'm still a little in shock about it," Harman said. "That was pretty wild. ... First one, you know, I looked at my caddie, I said, 'That's my first one out there.' He's like, 'Well, they come in bunches.' I was like, 'Yeah, whatever.'"

According to a variety of sources who cite odds for a hole-in-one, Harman's feat of two in one round happens 1 in every 67,000,000 times for the caliber of a Tour player. Considering that, it's surprising that Harman isn't the first to achieve the stunning feat. In fact, it's been done twice before. In 2006, Yusaku Miyazato made two aces in the second round in the Reno-Tahoe Open. In 1955, amateur W.W. "Bill" Whedon made two in the first round of the Insurance City Open.

Harman also nearly holed out from the fairway on the 17th hole, leaving his approach from 173 yards just two inches short. He couldn't see the ball as it was an uphill shot, but from hearing the crowd's reaction, he thought he had another hole out.

"It's like, 'Damn, man, I'm going to have three of these things today,'" Harman said about the shot on 17.

The aces were a good way for Harman to end a so-so week. He shot a final-round 2-under-par 68 and finished 2 under for the tournament and in the middle of the pack.

"I really had been struggling," Harman said. "This is a hard golf course. It was getting better throughout the week. It's good to at least get it for a couple. ... It's pretty cool. Obviously I'm trying to make a lot of holes-in-one. Hopefully I'll have a lot more, but definitely I'll remember this day for sure."

He might want to forget about the night. As is custom, Harman will be buying rounds of drinks for his friends, colleagues and others to celebrate the hole-in-ones. He and his wife, Kelly, were going into the city to attend the play *Book of Mormon* on Broadway. Many of his peers will be heading into Manhattan, as well, and they are bound to find Harman and some watering hole.

"It's gonna hurt," Harman said of the impending bar tab. "It's gonna hurt real bad. But it will be worth it."
