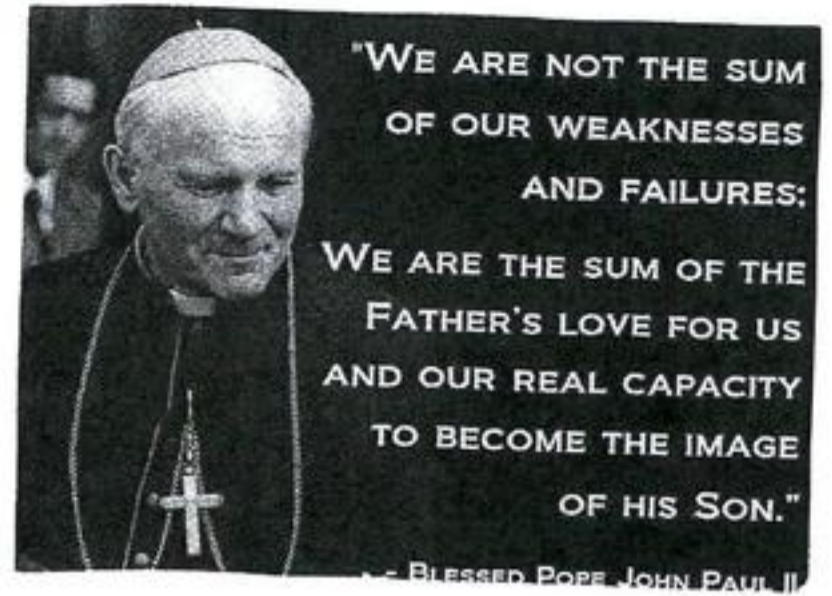

Based on its current performance *Jurassic World* has a chance of being the highest-grossing release of the year, potentially giving *Star Wars: The Force Awakens* a run for its money when it is released in December.

Little surprise then that talk of a sequel has already begun. The movie's star Chris Pratt suggested last week that a follow-up could be on the cards and confirmed that he is contracted to appear in any further films.

TAYLOR SWIFT CONVINCES APPLE TO PAY RECORD LABELS

Taylor Swift might be the most powerful person in music.

The "Bad Blood" singer wrote an open letter to Apple Music Sunday criticizing the company for not paying royalties as part of its streaming service. "I'm not sure you know that Apple Music will not be paying writers, producers, or artists for those three months," Swift, 25, wrote on Tumblr. "I find it to be shocking, disappointing and completely unlike this historically progressive and generous company."

Swift said she wrote the letter to help other musicians.

"This is about the new artist or band that has just released their first single and will not be paid for its success. This is about the young songwriter who just got his or her first cut and thought that the royalties from that would get them out of debt," she said. "This is about the producer who works tirelessly to innovate and create, just like the innovators and creators at Apple are pioneering in their field...but will not get paid for a quarter of a year's worth of plays on his or her songs."

Swift's pals Jack Antonoff and Christina Perri publicly supported the letter.

"Three months is a long time to go unpaid, and it is unfair to ask anyone to work for nothing," the "Style" singer said. "I say this with love, reverence, and admiration for everything else Apple has done...But I say to Apple with all due respect, it's not too late to change this policy and change the minds of those in the music industry who will be deeply and gravely affected by this. We don't ask you for free iPhones. Please don't ask us to provide you with our music for no compensation."

Swift was heard loud and clear. Hours after her open letter went viral, Apple's senior vice president of internet services and software Eddy Cue announced that the company will pay artists, even during the 90-day free trial period. "We hear you @taylorswift13 and indie artists. Love, Apple," Cue tweeted. Swift tweeted about the news, writing, "I am elated and relieved. Thank you for your words of support today. They listened to us."

In an interview with *Billboard*, Cue confirmed that Swift's letter had convinced him to make a change. "When I woke up this morning and saw what Taylor had written, it really solidified that we needed to make a change," he said. "And so that's why we decide we will now pay artists during the trial period."

Cue said Apple had heard the same "concern from a lot of artists," noting that it was "never our intent" to not compensate them, as the company originally planned to negotiate a higher royalty rate. Asked if Apple will eat the cost of the 90-day trial period, he said, "We're certainly paying for it, yes. We're all in."

Meanwhile, Swift's music will remain unavailable on Spotify.

Nasa's New Horizons Spacecraft Sends Colour 'Movies' of Pluto, Charon

The first colour movies from Nasa's New Horizons mission show Pluto and its largest moon Charon and the complex orbital dance of the two bodies, known as a double planet.

"It's exciting to see Pluto and Charon in motion and in colour," said New Horizons principal examiner Alan Stern of the Southwest Research Institute (SwRI) at Boulder, Colorado.

"Even at this low resolution, we can see that Pluto and Charon have different colours - Pluto is beige-orange, while Charon is grey. Exactly why they are so different is the subject of debate," Stern said.

New Horizons will be at the closest to Pluto on July 14, zipping by about 12,500km above the surface.

It is the first mission to Pluto and the Kuiper Belt, a relic of solar system formation beyond Neptune.

Sending a spacecraft on this almost three billion-mile journey will help astronomers answer basic questions about the surface

properties, atmospheres and moons of the Pluto system.

These near-true colour movies were assembled from images made in three colours - blue, red and near-infrared - by the multi-colour visible imaging camera on the instrument known as Ralph, inspired from "The Honeymooners", the classic American sitcom.

The images were taken on nine different occasions from May 29 to June 3.

Although the two movies were prepared from the same images, they display the Pluto-Charon pair from different perspectives.

One movie is "Pluto-centric", meaning that Charon is shown as it moves in relation to Pluto, which is digitally centred in the movie.

Pluto makes one turn around its axis every 6 days, 9 hours and 17.6 minutes - the same length of time that Charon rotates on its orbit.

"Colour observations are going to get much, much better, eventually resolving the surfaces of Charon and Pluto at scales of just kilometres," said Cathy Olkin, New Horizons deputy project scientist from SwRI.

"This will help us unravel the nature of their surfaces and the way volatiles transport around their surfaces. I can not wait, it is just a few weeks away."

U.S. Open 2015: Jordan Spieth proves he's 'The Daddy'

Bartholomew and other independently-owned eateries. His supplier's inventory has dwindled to meet demand and production is down because of testing by federal safety officials.

And the restaurant's overall production costs have gone up by 15 percent in recent weeks, so he says he'll have to raise prices soon.

"We're now having to use three or four different producers and call around to different chicken farms to see what is available and when it will be available," said Bartholomew, whose restaurant, Over Easy, serves breakfast and lunch with a focus on local ingredients. The restaurant has already taken strata — an egg casserole similar to quiche — off the menu.

The H5N2 avian flu virus began showing up in Midwest commercial turkey and chicken farms this spring. To date, 48 million turkeys and chickens have died or were euthanized to prevent the virus from spreading further.

The frequency of new cases has slowed dramatically in most states, though agriculture officials said last week that an Iowa chicken farm with 1 million egg-layers tested positive for the virus.

Because of the egg crisis, the U.S. Department of Agriculture lowered its forecast for table egg production this year to 6.9 billion dozen, a 5.3 percent drop from 2014. By late May, the price for a dozen Midwest large eggs had soared 120 percent from their mid-April, pre-bird flu prices to \$2.62, industry analyst group Urner Barry said.

Prices began falling last week, but officials say it could take up to two years to return to normal production.

"The best-case scenario, we're talking about a year before the availability is more robust," said John Howeth, the American Egg Board's senior vice president in charge of food service and egg product marketing.

A popular breakfast spot for more than 20 years in Des Moines is contemplating a surcharge of 50 cents to \$1 to each of their egg-heavy dishes because the cost of a cases of eggs has rocketed from \$18 to \$40 in just a few weeks.

"It's costing us between \$400 and \$500 a week," Waveland Cafe owner David "Stoney" Stone said.

It's not just independent restaurants being affected, either. Restaurant chains, which typically have set-price contracts for food supplies, have seen those deals rescinded.

Stock futures are surging

It's a good morning in global stock markets.

US stock futures are powering higher ahead of the open, and European stock markets are firmly in the green.

Near 7:31 a.m. ET, Dow futures were up 120 points, S&P 500 futures were up 15 points, and Nasdaq futures were up 37 points. On Friday, stocks closed lower after the Nasdaq set an all-time closing record the previous day.

US treasuries are lower, with the benchmark 10-year yield up about six basis points, or 0.06 percentage points, at 2.33%.

Greece urgently needs about \$8.2 billion to meet its due payment to the IMF on June 30.

"The PS4 system's games portfolio will continue to expand with highly anticipated titles from third-party publishers as well as SCE Worldwide Studios such as Sengoku Basara4 Sumeragi (Capcom Co., Ltd.), Metal Gear Solid V: The Phantom Pain (Konami Digital Entertainment Co., Ltd.), God Of War III Remastered, Until

Dawn, and The Tomorrow Children," the company writes in its press release.

The new PS4 dipped in Jet Black or Glacier White will initially be launched in Japan, followed by North America, Europe, and Asian countries.

The company has also announced a 1TB version of the PS4 dubbed 1TB PS4 Ultimate Player Edition. It is expected to launch on July 15, but there is no word on the pricing yet.

Obama secures Iran nuclear deal with Barbara Mikulski vote

Washington (CNN) In a major victory for President Barack Obama, Democratic Sen. Barbara Mikulski of Maryland announced support for the Iran nuclear deal Wednesday, providing the White House the votes it needs to prevent Republicans from scuttling the agreement.

The announcement means that at least 34 senators -- the number required by the Constitution to sustain a veto -- will back Obama's expected veto of a Republican resolution to disapprove of the deal. Mikulski is retiring at the end of her term.

While majorities of both the GOP-controlled House and Senate are poised to vote against the agreement, supporters of the multinational accord that aims to curb Iran's nuclear weapons program are also hoping to get the 41 votes needed to filibuster the bill and prevent it from even getting to a final vote in the Senate.

Secretary of State John Kerry said the administration will continue to try and push support for the deal past the 34 votes they now have "until the last moment."

"Thirty-four votes are obviously enough votes for the president's veto to be upheld," Kerry told CNN's Christiane Amanpour. "That is not satisfactory for us. We do want to try to go further. We'll continue to persuade."

That prospect upsets some Republicans who believe the historic agreement deserves a final up-or-down vote.

Nearly all Republicans have come out against the agreement, arguing it sets up weak standards for international inspectors to monitor whether Iran is complying with the agreement and would allow Iran to build nuclear weapons in a few years.

But only two Democratic senators -- Chuck Schumer of New York and Bob Menendez of New Jersey -- have announced they oppose it. The Senate's 54 Republicans would need four more Democrats to join them in opposing the deal to end the filibuster and send the bill disapproving of the deal for a vote.

The agreement, which took years for the so-called P5+1 -- the U.S., U.K., France, Germany, China and Russia -- to broker, has been the subject of intensive lobbying by both sides. Ultimately, opponents' multimillion-dollar campaign failed to resonate with enough of the Democratic lawmakers it was targeting.

Votes are expected after lawmakers return from a summer recess next week but before Sept. 17, the statutory deadline for Congress to act on the deal. But GOP leaders have not announced when those votes will take place.

House Speaker John Boehner's spokesman Cory Fritz said the White House shouldn't be celebrating.

"Forcing a bad deal, over the objections of the American people and a majority in Congress, is no win for President Obama. The White House may have convinced just enough Democrats to back an agreement that legitimizes Iran's nuclear program, trusts the regime to self-inspect and offers amnesty to terrorists, but this deal is far from being implemented," Fritz said.

The administration only needs one chamber to sustain its veto in order for the Iran deal to go through. House Democratic leadership aides are confident that they also have enough votes in the House to uphold a veto.

The Iran deal has been a charged topic in the 2016 presidential race and GOP, candidate Sen. Marco Rubio of Florida, a member of the Senate Foreign Relations Committee, was the first in the field to react to the 34th vote.

"When I'm President, we won't just reverse President Obama's dangerous Iran deal. We will increase sanctions on Iran," Rubio tweeted Wednesday.

Vice President Joe Biden, meanwhile, tweeted that "The #IranDeal is the best available option to block Iran from a bomb. It is in our national security interests."

The administration is clear it will continue to sell the Iran deal to the public as it looks to bolster the number of votes in favor of the deal and sway a divided public.

Following Mikulski's announced decision, Kerry will deliver a speech in Philadelphia continuing to make the case for the deal.

In his interview with CNN before the speech, Kerry said he would look to "dispel the myths" that he says opponents of the deal have propagated, instead laying out "specifically and factually what this agreement does and doesn't do."

He insisted the deal would make the world safer -- including Israel and the Gulf states that have expressed concerns -- by preventing Iran from obtaining a nuclear weapon, rather than paving a pathway toward a bomb, a charge of the fiercest critics.

Opponents say the billions of dollars in sanctions relief Iran will receive will bolster its terrorism-funding and other military operations that have contributed to an increasingly unstable Middle East.

But Kerry said the amount of money Iran will receive in sanctions relief will be much lower than what some critics have contended. And while Iran will receive a windfall of tens of billions of dollars, Kerry said he and the U.S. intelligence community are confident that windfall will not put money in the hands of terrorists.

"Some may find its way to some bad or nefarious activity, but the activities that we have objected to...are not just fueled by money. Much of the terrorism that has been supported in the region has been done on the cheap, not because of money," Kerry said.

"I don't believe that the money released by this...is going to be determinative in any way regarding the security of the region," he added.

Huge 920-pound gator captured in Alabama lake

The huge alligator recently caught in Lake Eufaula in Alabama weighed in at a whopping 920 pounds.

It took six men to pull in and secure the 13-foot 6-inch alligator, according to AL.com.

The reptile was caught by friends Scott Evans, Jeff and Justin Gregg on August 14. The gator was weighed at Dixon Lumber Co., AL.com reports.

The gator, which should produce about 250 pounds of meat, "won't go to waste," Evans told AL.com. He is planning a Labor Day cookout.

"It was surreal," Evans said. "We weren't expecting anything that big."

Apparently, the alligator got out of the first hook. Evans and his friends continued to follow it about another 75 yards and hooked it for the second time, the news organization reports.

Last year, a 15-foot, 9-inch gator weighing 1,011.5 pounds was caught in Meek Creek, a tributary of the Alabama River. About 115 pounds of that gator was a deer in the gator's stomach, the AP reports.

NTSB urges fire-resistant tanks for helicopters

Half a century after aviation officials first grew concerned about people burning to death in helicopter crashes, a federal safety agency is urging the installation of equipment that would prevent fuel leaks that have caused hundreds of fires, leading to scores of deaths and serious injuries.

The National Transportation Safety Board, in a July 23 letter, urged the Federal Aviation Administration to require rugged, crash-resistant fuel systems in all newly built civilian helicopters. Similar systems have been used in Army helicopters since the 1970s.

Fires have long been a helicopter hazard because they erupt after low-impact crashes and hard landings that pilots and passengers would survive if they weren't engulfed in flames or smoke. A USA TODAY investigation in 2014 found that 79 people had been killed and 28 injured by helicopter fires that occurred after low-impact crashes.

The NTSB pointed to the fiery crash Oct. 4 of a medical helicopter in Texas that caused a flight nurse and a paramedic to die from burns. In March, a helicopter pilot died from smoke inhalation and trauma following a crash in Mississippi that left a passenger with extensive burns.

The Army, facing major helicopter casualties in the Vietnam War, virtually eliminated the fires by installing high-strength, flexible fuel tanks and fuel lines that avoid rupture. But the civilian sector has been slower to respond,

"It's a huge loophole," said Gary Robb, a Kansas City, Mo., personal-injury lawyer who represents a paramedic who was burned across 90% of his body on July 3 when his medical helicopter crashed and burned in Colorado. "He would have walked away if this proposal had been implemented years ago. But he was horribly burned in the post-crash fire because of the defective fuel-system configuration."

The Air and Surface Transport Nurses Association said it "strongly supports" the NTSB proposal.

But even if the FAA accepts the recommendation, many of the roughly 10,000 helicopters flown in the U.S. would continue to operate for years or decades with easily ruptured fuel systems.

Installing a rugged fuel system on a new helicopter increases the manufacturing cost by 1% to 2%, said Tom Harrison, the recently retired CEO of Robertson Fuel Systems, which makes crash-resistant tanks. Harris said that requiring the systems on new helicopters might encourage owners to add them to their old helicopters.

The FAA, which has until late October to reply to the recommendation, said in a statement that "crashworthy fuel tanks can make a difference," although the agency took no official position. The FAA in recent years has been working to reduce the number of helicopter crashes. There were 143 helicopter crashes in the U.S. in 2014, causing 36 deaths, according to NTSB records. Most helicopter deaths are due to impact.

The FAA tried in 1994 to reduce fire-related helicopter deaths by requiring rugged fuel systems to be included in all new helicopter designs. But that regulation failed to eliminate the deaths, the NTSB said, because most new helicopters are built according to old designs, making the new helicopters exempt from the safety requirement.

Just 15% of the U.S. helicopters that were built since the 1994 regulation took effect have rugged fuel systems, the NTSB said, adding that without its recent proposal it would take until 2050 for half of the helicopter fleet to have the safety improvement.

"The NTSB has long been concerned about crash-resistant fuel systems in helicopters," NTSB spokesman Eric Weiss said.

In late 2010, after nine people were killed when a firefighting helicopter crashed and burned in Northern California, the NTSB urged the FAA to require rugged fuel systems to be added to large helicopters being flown in the U.S. The FAA rejected the recommendation, saying that despite the nine deaths it lacked "adequate safety data" to determine whether there was a widespread problem that would merit a fleet-wide retrofit.

Obama administration renames Mount McKinley to Denali

WASHINGTON — President Obama's three-day trip to Alaska this week will literally change the map of the nation's 49th state.

Mount McKinley — the 20,237-foot mountain and the tallest in North America — has been renamed Denali, as it was originally known by Alaska Natives before it was renamed to honor President William McKinley.

The mountain, which sits in the 6 million-acre Denali national park, has been known as Denali in Alaska since 1975. Under an order signed by Interior Secretary Sally Jewell, the Denali name will also take effect for all federal usage and, therefore, on all official maps.

The order was signed Friday, but the White House asked that it be announced Monday as part of Obama's trip to Alaska to highlight the effects of climate change in the Arctic. The White House said the name change "recognizes the sacred status of Denali to generations of Alaska Natives."

Denali, meaning "the great one" in the Athabaskan language of Alaska natives, was the original name of the mountain. But when European Americans discovered it in the 19th century, they renamed it Densmore's Mountain and, later, Mount McKinley in an effort to boost the presidential candidacy of Republican William McKinley.

But as Jewell noted in her order, "President McKinley never visited, nor did he have any significant historical connection to, the mountain or to Alaska."

The name became official with the Mount McKinley National Park Act in 1917.

The Obama administration's action breaks a 40-year impasse over the name of the mountain. Alaska has been petitioning for a name change since 1975, but a bipartisan effort by Ohio's congressional delegation has blocked the effort by introducing bills requiring it to be named after McKinley, who was born in Niles, Ohio and buried in Canton.

And for years, just introducing the bills was enough to block a name change. That's

because the United States Board on Geographic Names has a long-standing policy of not making name changes under consideration by Congress.

"While the board does have a policy of deferring action when a matter is being considered by Congress, contradictory bills on this issue have been proposed by various members of Congress since the late 1970s," Jewell said in her order. A 1947 law gives the secretary the authority to change names on her own when the board does not act in a reasonable time.

Obama visits receding glacier in Alaska to highlight climate change

SEWARD, Alaska — President Obama has often complained that Congress moves at a glacial pace, and on Tuesday saw a glacier that might be moving a bit faster than some pieces of legislation.

Standing near the foot of the Exit Glacier, which has receded 1.25 miles since 1815 and 187 feet last year alone, Obama said "this is as good of a signpost of what we're dealing with it comes to climate change as just about anything."

It was the second day of a trip melding a warning message about climate change and visits to some of the nation's most beautiful spots. In front of a gravelly creek bed, he said that when glaciers retreat, the water runs down and raises sea levels, altering the flora and fauna of the park.

"It is spectacular though," he said, sporting his aviator sunglasses. "We want to make sure that our grandkids can see this." Earlier he said it "beats being in the office."

The president traveled here by helicopter from Anchorage and, dressed in hiking shoes, black slacks and a greenish-gray Under Armour jacket, he went on to take a short hike up to the face of Exit Glacier, a massive two-mile-long ice block that flows down from the larger Harding Icefield.

Starting even before the park station, there are markers recording the years when the glacier extended further than it does today, beginning with the 1800s and moving up over the more than one mile of ferns, cottonwoods and alders that have grown up where the glacier once stood. Obama stopped for a moment just past the 1951 marker.

"What it indicates, because of the changing patterns of winter and less snow and longer, hotter summers, is how rapidly the glacier is receding. It sends a message," Obama said.

"Climate change is the primary driver for the retreat," said Deborah Kurtz, physical science program manager for Kenai Fjords National Park. She said that the aerial size of the Harding glacier had decreased by about 10 percent since 1950s.

Though the glacier looked like a snow-covered mass from a short distance, up close

Couple steps on WWII-era grenade at Colo. lake

BOULDER COUNTY, Colo. - A couple walking around a lake in Boulder County, Colo., found a dangerous relic from the World War II-era Tuesday evening. The Boulder County Sheriff's Office said Rachel Wine and Anthony Perkins were walking around Stearns Lake near Broomfield, in an area where the lake had receded, when they stepped on a hand grenade. Luckily, the live hand grenade did not detonate. The pair stopped and looked, realized what they had found and called 911. Boulder County deputies rushed to the lake and closed off the area. Deputies said Wine and Perkins were the only people at the lake at that time.

The Boulder County Regional Bomb Squad was called to the lake and determined the grenade was live, and likely from the WWII-era.

Bomb squad members said rust had developed on the grenade's surface and decided to use explosives to detonate it. The bomb squad successfully blew up the grenade. No one was injured and no property was damaged.

Deputies don't know how long ago the grenade had been thrown into the lake, or who was responsible for doing so. However, deputies say the couple was walking in an area where the lake's water had receded, causing them to conclude the device had been there for a while.

Obama: 'If Iran cheats, we can catch them and we will'

WASHINGTON — President Obama denounced critics of the international nuclear agreement with Iran Wednesday, calling the congressional vote "the most consequential foreign policy debate this country has had since the invasion of Iraq."

Obama's 56-minute speech evoked the bipartisan anti-nuclear legacies of presidents Kennedy and Reagan, while also taking sharp blows at critics of the deal. Obama suggested that Republican opposition was largely out of "knee-jerk partisanship." He taunted lobbyists and pundits who he said had become "armchair nuclear scientists." Of opposition from Israeli Prime Minister Benjamin Netanyahu, he said, "I do not doubt his sincerity, but I believe he is wrong."

"Unfortunately, we're living through a time in American politics when every foreign policy decision is read through a partisan prism," he said, noting that many who oppose diplomatic agreement with Iran also supported going to war with Iraq a decade ago.

"More than a decade later we still live with the consequences of the decision to invade Iraq," Obama said. "Ironically, the single biggest beneficiary of the war in that region was the Islamic Republic of Iran."

Obama's sharpest elbow came when he provocatively noted that Iranian hardliners also opposed the deal. "They're making

common cause with the Republican caucus," he said.

He did not explicitly refer to the significant number of Democrats who also oppose the deal, but he made a rare appeal to the American people to call their members of Congress to support it.

Since the Iran deal isn't a treaty, it doesn't need congressional approval. But under a law passed this spring, Congress can reject it with a two-thirds vote of both chambers — enough to sustain a veto. On Tuesday, the House Foreign Affairs Committee formally introduced a resolution to do just that, and House Majority Leader Kevin McCarthy promised a September vote once the House returns from its summer recess. Republicans condemned the speech as more partisan than substantive. A spokesman for House Speaker John Boehner, Cory Fritz, said Obama "is relying on partisan attacks, false claims and fear." Senators John McCain and Lindsey Graham said Obama raised "endless strawmen" in suggesting the only alternative to the agreement was war.

In a Senate address before Obama's speech, Majority Leader Mitch McConnell said the president should refrain from "tired, obviously untrue talking points about this being some choice between a bad deal and war."

Obama did not rule out military force against Iran in the future. "I've ordered military action in seven countries. There are times when force is necessary. And if Iran does not abide by this deal, it's possible we don't have an alternative," he said. "Our military remains the ultimate backstop to any agreement we make."

Attempting to rebut congressional criticism of the deal point-by-point, Obama argued that monitoring by the International Atomic Energy Agency would ensure Iran's compliance. "By the way, nuclear material is not something you can hide in a closet. It leaves a trace for years," he said, eliciting laughter from the audience at the university's School of International Service. "If Iran cheats, we can catch them and we will." He said the Iran deal, negotiated with the United Kingdom, France, Russia, China and Germany, is the "strongest non-proliferation agreement ever negotiated."

The venue for Obama's speech was intentional. It was at American University in 1963 — during the apex of the Cold War — that President Kennedy first proposed a nuclear test ban treaty, kicking off decades of nuclear negotiations with the Soviet Union.

"With all of the threats we face today, it's hard to appreciate how much more dangerous the world was at that time," Obama said. Like Kennedy, he called for a "practical and attainable peace."

Federal court says Texas voter ID violates Voting Rights Act

AUSTIN, Texas (AP) — Texas Attorney General Ken Paxton says the state's voter ID law "remains in effect" despite a federal

appeals court ruling that it violates the Voting Rights Act of 1965.

The New Orleans-based 5th Circuit Court of Appeals ruled that the 2011 Texas law runs afoul of parts of the federal Voting Rights Act — handing down the decision on the eve of the 50th anniversary of the landmark civil rights law.

The ruling is a victory for President Barack Obama, whose administration took the unusual step of bringing the weight of the U.S. Justice Department to fight a wave of new ballot-box restrictions passed in conservative statehouses.

Opponents cheered the ruling. But Paxton, in a statement, called it "a victory on the fundamental question of Texas' right to protect the integrity of our elections." He said Texas has held three elections under the law with "no disenfranchisement reported."

Paxton has been ordered to appear in a federal court next Wednesday after a Houston gay man was not provided an amended death certificate for his husband.

The hearing is to determine whether Paxton and a top Texas Department of State Health Services official should be held in contempt after potentially disobeying a July 7 court order barring the state from enforcing any laws that impede the U.S. Supreme Court's landmark decision recognizing gay marriage. The court order comes two days after Paxton was booked on securities fraud charges.

Texas was allowed to use the voter ID law during the 2014 elections, thereby requiring an estimated 13.6 million registered Texas voters to have a photo ID to cast a ballot. The ruling was a victory, albeit not a sweeping one, for Democrats and minority rights groups. Whereas a Texas federal judge last year called the voter ID law the equivalent of a poll tax, a three-judge panel of the New Orleans court disagreed. It instead sent the law back to the lower court to consider how to fix the discriminatory effects.

"I'm particularly pleased the panel saw through and rejected the plaintiffs' claim that our law constituted a 'poll tax.' The intent of this law is to protect the voting process in Texas, and we will continue to defend this important safeguard for all Texas voters," Paxton said.

Other Republican-controlled states, including Wisconsin and North Carolina, have passed similar voter ID measures in recent years, but the Texas law signed by then-Gov. Rick Perry is widely viewed as one of the nation's toughest. It requires one of seven forms of approved identification, a list that included concealed carry licenses but not a college student's university ID.

"Today's ruling is a victory for every Texas voter. Once again, the rule of law agrees with Democrats. The Republican voter ID law is discriminatory," Texas Democratic Party Chairman Gilberto Hinojosa said in a statement.
